RIALTO CITY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT FOR THE 2025-2029 FIVE YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Rialto City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 24, 2025, as follows: Date : Tuesday, June 24, 2025 (City Council Meeting) Time: 6:30 p.m. (or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard) Place: In person Public Meeting City Hall Council Chambers, 150 S. Palm Avenue, Rialto, CA 92376 Subject: Rialto City Council will conduct a public hearing for citizens' input on the upcoming draft five-year 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan. As an entitlement jurisdiction, the City is required by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to complete the Consolidated Plan (ConPlan) and Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice every five years. Furthermore, the City is required to conduct a public hearing to receive input and provide direction concerning the draft Five-Year Consolidated Plan for the allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) program funds. The purpose of the ConPlan is to identify Rialto's housing and community development needs, priorities, goals, and strategies and to stipulate how funds will be allocated to housing and community development activities over the next five years. The CDBG Program provides federal funds for local improvement projects and programs. Activities assisted with CDBG funds must meet one of the three national objectives: principally benefit low and moderate-income persons, aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight, or meet other community development needs having particular urgency. The HOME Program provides formula grants - often in partnership with local nonprofit groups - to fund a wide range of activities including building, buying, and/or rehabilitating affordable housing or providing direct rental assistance to low-income people. HOME is the largest Federal block grant to state and local governments designed exclusively to create affordable housing for low-income households.

- The Consolidated Plan is a five-year plan detailing the priorities and needs of the community for the use of CDBG and HOME funds.
- The Annual Action Plan is submitted to HUD on an annual



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basis and identifies how the City plans to use the federal money during the next fiscal year to meet the goals and objectives approved by the City Council in the Five-Year Consolidated Plan.

- The Citizen Participation Plan sets forth the City of Rialto's policies and procedures for citizen participation in the development of the Consolidated Plan Documents and any subsequent amendments. The CPP provides an opportunity for nonprofit service agencies and the community to work in partnership with the City to identify needs and allocate CDBG and HOME funds.

- This draft Consolidated Plan covers the period from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2030. Included within this Consolidated Plan is the Annual Action Plan for the period July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, otherwise known as the 2025 program year. Availability of Document for Public Comment: The City of Rialto encourages citizen participation in the planning process. The Draft 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan which includes the Draft Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Annual Action Plan; and Citizen Participation Plan will be available for a 30-day public review and comment period beginning on May 23, 2025, through June 24, 2025.
