A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING AN ADDENDUM TO THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE (6TH 2021-2029 CYCLE) GENERAL **PLAN** HOUSING **PROGRAM** (ENVIRONMENTAL **ELEMENT REZONE** ASSESSMENT REVIEW NO. 2022-0083) PREPARED IN **ACCORDANCE** WITH **CEQA FOR** A **PROJECT** CONSISTING OF ZONING CODE AMENDMENT NO. 2022-0004, SPECIFIC PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 2022-0006, SPECIFIC PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 2022-0007, AND SPECIFIC PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 2022-0008, WHICH RESIDENTIAL **ESTABLISH** A **OVERLAY** ACCOMMODATE HOUSING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE **ELEMENT** HOUSING **REZONE PROGRAM** IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2022 the City Council adopted the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element Goal #2, Housing Program 2B, referred to as the Rezone Program, the City will need to rezone parcels to provide adequate sites to accommodate the City's Regional Housing Needs Allocation; and

WHEREAS, the Rezone Program is comprised of Zoning Code Amendment No. 2022-0004, Specific Plan Amendment No. 2022-0006, Specific Plan Amendment No. 2022-0007, and Specific Plan Amendment No. 2022-0008, which collectively establish a residential overlay to accommodate housing ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15164(a), Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et. seq. ("CEQA"), the State's CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15000 et. seq., the City prepared an Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2022-0083) prepared by Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and determined that the proposed Project will not result in any new significant impacts that were not analyzed in the Mitigated Negative

Declaration for the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element ("MND 6th Cycle Housing Element"), nor would the proposed Project cause a substantial increase in the severity of any previously identified environmental impacts. The potential impacts associated with the proposed Project would either be the same or less than those described in the MND 6th Cycle Housing Element. In addition, there are no substantial changes to the circumstances under which the proposed Project would be undertaken that would result in new or more severe environmental impacts than previously addressed in the MND 6th Cycle Housing Element, nor has any new information regarding the potential for new or more severe significant environmental impacts been identified; and

WHEREAS, the City published the public hearing notice in the San Bernardino Sun newspaper, mailed the notice to property owners, and posted in public places as required by State law; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2023, the Planning Commission of the City of Rialto conducted a duly noticed public hearing, as required by law, on the Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2022-0083), ZCA No. 2022-0004, SPA No. 2022-0006, SPA No. 2022-0007, and SPA No. 2022-0008, heard testimony, at which time it received input from staff and the city attorney; received public testimony; discussed the proposed Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2022-0083), ZCA No. 2022-0004, SPA No. 2022-0006, SPA No. 2022-0007, and SPA No. 2022-0008; and closed the public hearing; and

WHERAS, the Planning Commission voted 5-0 to recommend the City Council approve the amendment to the proposed Addendum to the Mitigate Negative Declaration; and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2023, the City Council of the City of Rialto conducted a duly noticed public hearing, as required by law, on the Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2022-0083), ZCA No. 2022-0004, SPA No. 2022-0006, SPA No. 2022-0007, and SPA No. 2022-0008, heard testimony, at which time it received input from staff and the

whereas, on July 25, 2023, the City Council of the City of Rialto conducted a duly noticed public hearing, as required by law, on the Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2022-0083), ZCA No. 2022-0004, SPA No. 2022-0006, SPA No. 2022-0007, and SPA No. 2022-0008, heard testimony, at which time it received input from staff and the city attorney; received public testimony; discussed the proposed Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2022-0083), ZCA No. 2022-0004, SPA No. 2022-0006, SPA No. 2022-0007, and SPA No. 2022-0008; and closed the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rialto, California, does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby specifically finds that the facts set forth in the recitals above of this Resolution are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City of Rialto is the Lead Agency for the Project, as determined by CEQA. Based on the Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 2021-2029 (6th Cycle) General Plan Housing Element (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2022-0083), it has been determined that:

 There are no substantial changes to the Project or the circumstances under which the Project will be carried out that will require major revisions to the previously certified Mitigated Negative Declaration.

- 2. The Project will not result in new significant environmental effects or substantial increases in the severity of previously identified significant effects.
- 3. There is no new information of substantial importance, which was known or could have been known with the exercise of reasonable diligence at the time the previous Mitigated Negative Declaration was certified.
- 4. The Project will not have any significant effects that are not identified and discussed in the previously certified Mitigated Negative Declaration, and there are no newly feasible, or considerably different, mitigation measures or alternatives which would substantially reduce one or more significant effects of the Project which the applicant declines to adopt.

SECTION 3. For the foregoing reasons and based on the information and findings included in the Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration, Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, Staff Report, public testimony, and all other documents and evidence in the administrative record of proceedings, the City Council has determined that the Project, as mitigated, will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and also finds that the preparation of the Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration attached hereto complies with CEQA. Therefore, the City Council hereby certifies the Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, making certain environmental findings to allow the Project.

SECTION 4. The Mayor shall sign the passage and adoption of this resolution and thereupon the same shall take effect and be in force.
