3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
4 RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR  
5 FISCAL YEAR 2023/2024 FUNDED BY SB-1: THE ROAD REPAIR  
6 AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017.

7 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017  
8 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the  
9 Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls  
10 statewide; and

11 WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure  
12 the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and  
13 which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Rialto must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to  
15 receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA),  
16 created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project,  
17 a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the  
18 improvement; and

19 WHEREAS, the City of Rialto, will receive an estimated \$2,523,452 in RMRA funding  
20 in Fiscal Year 2023-24 from SB 1; and

21 WHEREAS, on April 11, 2018, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution  
22 no. 7318 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

23 WHEREAS, on April 23, 2019, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution  
24 no. 7499 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

25 WHEREAS, on April 29, 2020, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution  
26 no. 7605 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

27 WHEREAS, on June 8, 2021, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution  
28 no. 7731 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

1           **WHEREAS**, on June 14, 2022, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution  
2 no. 7908 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

3           **WHEREAS**, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1  
4 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective  
5 projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

6           **WHEREAS**, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate  
7 streets/roads throughout the City this year and into the future; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment  
9 found that the City's streets and roads are in an "at-risk" condition and this revenue will help  
10 us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our  
11 streets and roads into a "good" condition; and

12           **WHEREAS**, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads  
13 infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets  
14 infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant  
15 positive co-benefits statewide.

16           **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES HEREBY**  
17 **FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

18           **Section 1:** The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

19           **Section 2:** The City of Rialto hereby provides the list of previously proposed and  
20 adopted projects attached hereto as **Exhibits A, B, C, D and E** that will be funded in part or  
21 solely with Fiscal Year 2023- 24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in  
22 their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City  
23 of Rialto is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road  
24 Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.
