3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, TO APPROVE THE SAFE STREETS AND
5 ROADS FOR ALL FINAL SAFETY ACTION PLAN.

6 WHEREAS, the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, adopted in 2021, established the new
7 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) discretionary program with \$5 billion in appropriated
8 funds over the subsequent five years; and

9
10 WHEREAS, the SS4A program funds regional, local, and Tribal initiatives through
11 grants to prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries; and

12 WHEREAS, the SS4A Safety Plan aims to improve roadway safety by developing a
13 comprehensive safety action plan based on a Safe System Approach and implementing
14 projects and strategies that significantly reduce or eliminate transportation-related fatalities and
15 serious injury accidents; and

17 WHEREAS, on September 13, 2022, the City Council approved staff's request to submit
18 a grant totaling \$320,000, requiring a local match of \$80,000; and

19
20 WHEREAS, on February 22, 2023, staff received notification from the Federal Highway
21 Administration (FHWA) California Division that the City of Rialto had successfully obtained a
22 grant award for \$320,000 to develop a Safe Streets for All Action Plan; and

23 WHEREAS, on May 9, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution 8071, accepting the
24 Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant through the FHWA in the amount of \$320,000 for the
25 Development of a Safe Streets and Roads For All Action Plan; and

27 WHEREAS, on January 9, 2024, the City Council awarded a Professional Services
28 Agreement to Kimley-Horn and Associates for the Development of the SS4A Action Plan; and

1 **WHEREAS**, on March 28, 2025, the Department of Transportation issued a Notice of
2 Funding Opportunity (NOFO) to solicit grant applications for SS4A-related project funding; and

3 **WHEREAS**, on April 24, 2025, the Action Plan was provided to the Economic
4 Development Committee for comments; and

5 **WHEREAS**, at the end of June 2025, City staff submitted an application to the
6 Department of Transportation in response to the NOFO issued in March 2025 for the Planning
7 and Implementation of SS4A projects; and

8 **WHEREAS**, approval of the Final Safety Action Plan is required for agencies seeking
9 eligibility for safety-related grant funding opportunities, such as the Highway Safety
10 Improvement Program (HSIP).

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES HEREBY**
14 **FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

15 **Section 1:** Approve the Safe Streets and Roads for All Final Safety Action Plan.
