A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, TO APPROVE THE SAFE STREETS AND
ROADS FOR ALL FINAL SAFETY ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, adopted in 2021, established the new Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) discretionary program with \$5 billion in appropriated funds over the subsequent five years; and

WHEREAS, the SS4A program funds regional, local, and Tribal initiatives through grants to prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries; and

WHEREAS, the SS4A Safety Plan aims to improve roadway safety by developing a comprehensive safety action plan based on a Safe System Approach and implementing projects and strategies that significantly reduce or eliminate transportation-related fatalities and serious injury accidents; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2022, the City Council approved staff's request to submit a grant totaling \$320,000, requiring a local match of \$80,000; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2023, staff received notification from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) California Division that the City of Rialto had successfully obtained a grant award for \$320,000 to develop a Safe Streets for All Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on May 9, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution 8071, accepting the Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant through the FHWA in the amount of \$320,000 for the Development of a Safe Streets and Roads For All Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2024, the City Council awarded a Professional Services Agreement to Kimley-Horn and Associates for the Development of the SS4A Action Plan; and

1 **WHEREAS**, on March 28, 2025, the Department of Transportation issued a Notice of
2 Funding Opportunity (NOFO) to solicit grant applications for SS4A-related project funding; and

3 **WHEREAS**, on April 24, 2025, the Action Plan was provided to the Economic
4 Development Committee for comments; and

5 **WHEREAS**, at the end of June 2025, City staff submitted an application to the
6 Department of Transportation in response to the NOFO issued in March 2025 for the Planning
7 and Implementation of SS4A projects; and

8 **WHEREAS**, approval of the Final Safety Action Plan is required for agencies seeking
9 eligibility for safety-related grant funding opportunities, such as the Highway Safety
10 Improvement Program (HSIP).

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES HEREBY
12 FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

13 **Section 1:** Approve the Safe Streets and Roads for All Final Safety Action Plan.
