



1 are Miscellaneous Members, and implementing the 3% at 50 Full formula for its employees who are  
2 Safety Members; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the change in benefit formula for the Miscellaneous Members and Safety Members  
4 pursuant to Ordinance No. 1467 was effective November 21, 2010; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the CGMA bargaining unit consisting of Executive Management Team employees  
6 is no longer a recognized bargaining unit and has subsequently been replaced by the unrepresented  
7 Executive Management Team (EXEC) group effective July 1, 2020, and

8 **WHEREAS**, the City Council has a written labor policy or agreement which specifically  
9 provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the employer, and reported as additional  
10 compensation; and

11 **WHEREAS**, one of the steps in the procedures to implement Section 20691 is the adoption by  
12 the City Council of a Resolution to commence paying and reporting the value of said EPMC; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the City Council has identified the following conditions for the purpose of its  
14 election to pay EPMC pursuant to this Resolution:

- 15 • This benefit shall apply to all “Classic” Miscellaneous Members and “Classic” Safety  
16 Members who are employees of the Executive Management Team (EXEC) group, the  
17 Rialto Police Benefits Association Management Bargaining Unit, the Rialto Professional  
18 Firefighters Local 3688 Bargaining Unit, and the Rialto Fire Management Association.
- 19 • This benefit shall consist of paying eight percent (8%) of the normal contributions as  
20 EPMC, and reporting the same percent (value) of compensation earnable (excluding  
21 Government Code Section 20636 (c)(4) as additional compensation for the “Classic”  
22 miscellaneous employees.
- 23 • This benefit shall consist of paying nine percent (9%) of the normal contributions as  
24 EPMC, and reporting the same percent (value) of compensation earnable (excluding  
25 Government Code Section 20636 (c)(4) as additional compensation for the “Classic”  
26 safety employees.
- 27 • The effective date of this Resolution shall be November 21, 2010.
