A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, FOR PAYING AND REPORTING THE VALUE OF EMPLOYEE MEMBER PAID CONTRIBUTIONS

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Rialto, (the "City Council"), has the authority to implement Government Code Section 20636 (c) (4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

WHEREAS, on November 24, 2009, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 5771 approving the paying and reporting the value of Employee Member Paid Contributions (EPMC) on behalf of employees within the Rialto Professional Firefighters Local 3688 bargaining unit in accordance with their Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) with EMPC for safety member contributions reported at nine percent (9%) of the normal contributions and reporting same percent (value) of compensation earnable (excluding Government Code Section 20646(c)(4)); and

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2009, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 5784 approving the paying and reporting the value of EPMC on behalf of employees within the City Government Management Association (CGMA) and Fire Management bargaining units in accordance with their MOUs with EMPC for local miscellaneous member contributions reported at seven percent (7%) and safety member contributions reported at nine percent (9%), all reported of the normal contributions and reporting same percent (value) of compensation earnable (excluding Government Code Section 20646(c)(4)); and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2010, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 5803 approving the paying and reporting the value of EPMC on behalf of employees within the Police Management Bargaining Unit in accordance with the MOU with the EMPC for local miscellaneous member contributions reported at seven percent (7%) and safety member contributions reported at nine percent (9%), all reported of the normal contributions and reporting same percent (value) of compensation earnable (excluding Government Code Section 20646(c)(4)); and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2010, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1467 authorizing an amendment to the Contract between the City Council and the Board of Administration of the California Public Employees' Retirement System implementing the 2.7% at 55 Full formula for its employees who

are Miscellaneous Members, and implementing the 3% at 50 Full formula for its employees who are Safety Members; and

WHEREAS, the change in benefit formula for the Miscellaneous Members and Safety Members pursuant to Ordinance No. 1467 was effective November 21, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the CGMA bargaining unit consisting of Executive Management Team employees is no longer a recognized bargaining unit and has subsequently been replaced by the unrepresented Executive Management Team (EXEC) group effective July 1, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has a written labor policy or agreement which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the employer, and reported as additional compensation; and

WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement Section 20691 is the adoption by the City Council of a Resolution to commence paying and reporting the value of said EPMC; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has identified the following conditions for the purpose of its election to pay EPMC pursuant to this Resolution:

- This benefit shall apply to all "Classic" Miscellaneous Members and "Classic" Safety
 Members who are employees of the Executive Management Team (EXEC) group, the
 Rialto Police Benefits Association Management Bargaining Unit, the Rialto Professional
 Firefighters Local 3688 Bargaining Unit, and the Rialto Fire Management Association.
- This benefit shall consist of paying eight percent (8%) of the normal contributions as EPMC, and reporting the same percent (value) of compensation earnable (excluding Government Code Section 20636 (c)(4) as additional compensation for the "Classic" miscellaneous employees.
- This benefit shall consist of paying nine percent (9%) of the normal contributions as EPMC, and reporting the same percent (value) of compensation earnable (excluding Government Code Section 20636 (c)(4) as additional compensation for the "Classic" safety employees.
- The effective date of this Resolution shall be November 21, 2010.
