Director Alvarado gave updates on department programming:

- 49 Shelter Rentals, 26 facility rentals for October
- 26 Cemetery requests (plot selection, purchase, vase installation) 1 burial.
- Ebike program: 297 sign ups, 174 active riders, 313 total trips
- Held Viva la Fiesta, event went well, 2 stages with entertainment, a few alters remembering loved ones.

- Mark your calendars: Halloween Hi-Jinks October 31st, Floating Pumpkins October 21st, Soctober is going on all month, Rialto Heritage Days November 18, and Rialto Holiday Festival & Parade December 2nd.
- On September 9th the Hall of Fame honored Andrew Bock and Emmett Gillard
- Teen Club is going well. On September 15th they held a Mario Kart tournament.
- Mobile Recreation is going well. The program is at Joe Sampson. The program has a lot of participants on Thursday.
- Fitness Center is going well. They held their health and wellness Fair on September 21st. Had a good turn.
- Grace Vargas Senior Center held their Health and Wellness Fair and had a great turn out. They held their last ice cream social of the year and had 50 attendees, their monthly food give away provided food for 150 Rialto families, 20th anniversary of the Grace Vargas Senior Center was held. Supervisor Baca Jr. presented the Friends of the senior center with a proclamation thanking them for all their support of the center. The programs show cased their products and talents.
- NSG gave away equipment to the seniors (wheels chairs, show chairs, canes etc)
- Youth sports is going well. The new upcoming season is full. Some rules have been updated.
- Contract classes are going well. Polynesian dance class is picking up in registration.
