A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES URBAN COMMUNITY DROUGHT RELIEF GRANT FUNDS FOR \$6,000,000 AND THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, BUREAU OF RECLAMATION GRANT FUNDS FOR \$2,000,000 FOR THE ADVANCED METERING INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT; APPROPRIATING \$350,00 FROM WATER RATE STABILIZATION FOR THE ADVANCED METERING INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT; AMENDING THE CITY'S 2025-2026 FISCAL BUDGET TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF SUCH FUNDS FOR THE ADVANCED METERING INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE FINAL CONSTRUCTION WORK AUTHORIZATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,998,719 TO RIALTO WATER SERVICES FOR THE **PURPOSES OF** THE ADVANCED **METERING** INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THEIR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Rialto Utility Authority Concession Agreement ("RUA Concession Agreement"), Rialto Water Services ("RWS") operates and maintains the water and sewer system in the City of Rialto; and

WHEREAS, RWS has entered into an agreement with Veolia North Operating Services, Inc. ("Veolia") to operate and maintain the water and sewer system in the City of Rialto pursuant to the RUA Concession Agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the RUA Concession Agreement between the Rialto Utility Authority and RWS, the parties established a Water Trust Agreement to provide the financial framework for the receipt, deposit, accounting, and disbursement of revenues, reimbursements, and expenditures associated with water and wastewater utility operations and capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Rialto Utilities Authority ("RUA"), RWS, and Veolia are in the process of carrying out the Advanced Metering Infrastructure Project, City Project No. 26AMI, which would replace existing manual-read water meters with smart meters and supporting communication infrastructure to enable real-time, automated collection of water usage data, improve billing accuracy, enhance leak

detection, and provide customers with timely information to manage their water consumption (the "AMI Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City applied to the State of California Department of Water Resources for grant funding in the amount of \$6,000,000 for the purposes of funding the AMI Project, and such application was approved by the State of California Department of Water Resources; and

WHEREAS, the City applied to the U.S. Department of the Interior for grant funding in the amount of \$2,000,000 for the purposes of funding the AMI Project, and such application was approved by the U.S. Department of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the budget for fiscal year 2025-2026 of the City of Rialto has been adopted by this Council in its original form, and said budget will need to be amended at times to fulfill the goals of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City departments may not exceed their appropriations by character of expense, with character of expense being defined as personnel services, services and supplies, capital outlay, debt service, and transfers, without the consent of the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager may transfer appropriations between departments and within their respective funds, as long as those appropriations do not exceed their fund total unless approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the FY 2025-2026 Budget to authorize the Veolia Recovery, 2017-24 Project Development fee of \$350,000 (funded from the \$8,000,000 grant appropriation cited herein) to be paid from the Water Fund's Rate Stabilization Account; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the FY 2025-2026 Budget to authorize the appropriation and expenditure of these grant funds for the AMI Project in accounts 56707960-47536 and 56707960-53001 Project No. 26AMI, and to approve related actions necessary to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, in order to accept and utilize the aforementioned grant funding for the purposes of the AMI Project and to authorize the AMI Project, the City Council must take certain actions related thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Rialto hereby approves Agreement Number 4600015365 Urban Community Drought Relief Grant Funds of \$6,000,000 ("Agreement Number 4600015365") and accepts the grant funding in the amount of \$6,000,000 from the State of California Department of Water Resources as described in Agreement Number 4600015365.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Rialto hereby approves Agreement Number R22AP00556-02 WaterSMART Grant Funds of \$2,000,000 ("Agreement Number R22AP00556-02") and accepts the grant funding from the U.S. Department of the Interior as described in Agreement Number R22AP00556-02.

Section 4. Upon receipt of the aforementioned grant funds, the City Council of the City of Rialto hereby amends the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Budget to authorize an increase in estimated revenues in the total amount of \$8,000,000 in the RUA Concession Agreement Grant Funding Account for the purposes of funding the AMI Project.

1	Section 5. Upon receipt of the aforementioned grant funds, the City Council of the City of
2	Rialto hereby authorizes the reimbursement of up to \$8,000,000 in AMI Project grant funds into the Water
3	Trust Agreement Account, as AMI Project expenses are incurred and as described above in Section 4,
4	consistent with applicable grant reimbursement requirements and the Concession Agreement.
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6	Section 6. The City Council of the City of Rialto hereby approves and authorizes a Final
7	Construction Work Authorization ("FCWA") in the Amount of \$7,998,719 to RWS, as operated by
8	Veolia, pursuant to the RUA Concession Agreement with the Rialto Utility Authority to implement the
9	AMI Project.
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11	Section 7. The City Manager, or their designee, is hereby authorized to execute all necessary
12	agreements, amendments, and related documents with the State of California Department of Water
13	Resources, the U.S. Department of the Interior, and any eligible sub-recipients to implement the AMI
14	Project and to ensure compliance with grant requirements and the RUA Concession Agreement.
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16	Section 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
