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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING STAFF TO INITIATE THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION (LAFCO) ANNEXATION FILING PROCESS FOR ANNEXATION NO. 2025-0001, A REORGANIZATION THAT INCLUDES ANNEXATION OF FIVE (5) PARCELS OF LAND (APN's: 0264-431-04, -17, -18, -19, & -20), AND APPROPRIATE DISTRICTS, SERVICES AREAS, AND RIGHT-OF-WAY, FROM THE COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO TO THE CITY OF RIALTO.

WHEREAS, the City of Rialto desires to initiate proceedings pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 (Section 56000 et seq. of the Government Code) for the reorganization of unincorporated territory that includes the annexation of five (5) parcels of land (APN's: 0264-431-04, -17, -18, -19, & -20), depicted on "Exhibit A" and attached hereto and incorporated by the reference; and

WHEREAS, the reorganization area is consistent with the Sphere of Influence of the City of Rialto; and

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rialto hereby finds, determines, and resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby specifically finds that all facts set forth in the recitals above of this Resolution are true and correct and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Council authorizes staff to initiate the San Bernardino County Local Area Formation Commission (LAFCO) filing process, including the submission of application materials for the reorganization, which includes a certified Plan for Services and Fiscal Impact Analysis.

SECTION 3. The adoption of a Resolution initiating the annexation filing process is not a “Project” as defined by CEQA and is therefore not subject to further environmental review. Pursuant to Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act, a “Project” means the whole of an action, which has the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment, or

1 a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. A project does not include
2 administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in
3 the environment.

4 **SECTION 4.** The proposed reorganization will be subject to all standards terms and
5 conditions required by the San Bernardino County Local Agency Formation Commission.

6 **SECTION 5.** The City of Rialto acknowledges and agrees to the San Bernardino County
7 Local Agency Formation Commission's requirement for imposing legal indemnification as outlined
8 in Policies 10 and 11 of its Accounting and Financial Division of its Policy and Procedure Manual
9 adopted June 2012.

10 **SECTION 6.** The Mayor shall sign the passage and adoption of this resolution and
11 thereupon the same shall take effect and be in force.
