7	WHEREAS, the City of Rialto ("City") is a municipal corporation, duly organized under		
8	the constitution and laws of the State of California; and		
9	WHEREAS, the City of Rialto's Mayor, City Council, City Treasurer, and City Clerk hold		
10	elected offices; and		
11	WHEREAS, Section 36512 of the Government Code provides the process that general law		
12	cities must follow to fill an elected office vacancy, other than an elected mayor; and		
13	WHEREAS, Sections 34902 of the Government Code provides the process that general law		
14	cities must follow to fill an elected mayor vacancy; and		
15	WHEREAS, the City has not adopted a process, consistent with state law, to fill any such		
16	vacancies; and		
17	WHEREAS, it is the purpose and intent of the City Council in enacting this ordinance to		
18	adopt regulations that will provide guidance and consistency for the filling of the City's elected		
19	office vacancies going forward.		
20	NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO ORDAINS AS		
21	FOLLOWS:

23	The City Council hereby finds that all of the foregoing recitals and the staff report presented

11	SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY		
12	If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance		
13	is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competen		
14	jurisdiction, then such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this		
15	ordinance. The City Council hereby declares it would have adopted this Ordinance and each		
16	section, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that one of		
17	more section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof be declared		
18	invalid or unconstitutional.		
19	SECTION 6. CERTIFICATION, PUBLICATION, AND EFFECTIVE DATE		
20	The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and publish and post the		
21	ordinance in accordance with Government Code Section 36933. This ordinance shall take effect		
22	thirty (30) days after its date of adoption.

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shall hold office until the next general municipal election that is scheduled 130 or more days after the date the city council is notified of the vacancy, and thereafter until the person who is elected at that election to fill the vacancy has been qualified. The person elected to fill the vacancy shall hold office for the unexpired balance of the term of office.

- ii. If the vacancy occurs in the first half of a term of office, but less than 130 days prior to the next general municipal election, the person appointed to fill the vacancy shall hold office for the unexpired term of the former incumbent.
- iii. If the vacancy occurs in the second half of the term of office, the person appointed to fill the vacancy shall hold office for the unexpired term of the former incumbent.
- b. If the city council fails to fill the vacancy within the 60 day period, then if shall call a special election which shall be held on the next regularly established election date not less than 114 days from the call of the special election. A person elected to fill a vacancy holds office for the unexpired term of the former incumbent.
- D. In the event that the city council elects to transition the City to by-district elections, and elects to fill a vacancy by appointment as a result of a councilmember resigning from office, the appointment shall be made in accordance with Section 36512(e), including any amendments or successor statutes thereto.
- E. An appointment pursuant to this section shall not be made to fill a city council or mayor vacancy if the appointment would result in a majority of the members serving on the city council having been appointed. In the event that the appointment of a mayor or councilmember would result in a majority of the members serving on the city council having been appointed, the vacancy shall be filled as follows:
 - 1. The city council may call an election to fill the vacancy, to be held on the next regularly established election date not less than 114 days after the call.
 - 2. If the city council does not call an election pursuant to paragraph (1), the vacancy shall be filled at the next regularly established election date.
