## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-61**

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA APPROVING A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE FOOTHILL CENTRAL SPECIFIC PLAN (ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT REVIEW (EAR) NO. 2024-002) TO AMEND AND MERGE THE EXISTING CITY OF RIALTO FOOTHILL BOULEVARD SPECIFIC PLAN AND CENTRAL AREA SPECIFIC PLAN INTO THE "FOOTHILL CENTRAL SPECIFIC PLAN".

WHEREAS, the City of Rialto ("applicant") has initiated the Foothill Central Specific Plan Amendment (SPA) No. 2022-004 (Master Case No. 2022-075) project to update and merge the existing City of Rialto Foothill Boulevard and Central Area Specific Plans into the Foothill Central Specific Plan (Proposed Project). The Proposed Project increases the allowable residential density within the Foothill Central Area and provides updates to the development guidelines for this area while preserving existing land uses located on the east side of Cactus Avenue approximately 360 feet south of Foothill Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the The Foothill Central Specific Plan Area encompasses parcels adjacent to the north and south sides of Foothill Boulevard throughout the City of Rialto and is bounded by Maple Avenue to the west and Pepper Avenue to east. The project site also encompasses Merrill Avenue to the south, Foothill Boulevard to the north, Willow Avenue to the west, and Sycamore Avenue to the east; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15164(a), Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et. seq. ("CEQA"), the State's CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15000 et. seq., and Government Code Section 65962.5(f) (Hazardous Waste and Substances Statement), the City reviewed an Addendum to the 2010 Foothill Boulevard Specific Plan Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared , Exhibit "A" hereto, and determined that the proposed Project would result in no new significant impacts with mitigations incorporated, nor would the proposed Project cause a substantial increase in the severity of any previously identified environmental impacts. In addition, there are no substantial changes to the circumstances under which the proposed Project would be undertaken

that would result in severe environmental impacts, nor has any new information regarding the potential for new or more severe significant environmental impacts been identified; and

WHEREAS, the City placed a 1/8 page public hearing notice for the proposed Project in the San Bernardino Sun newspaper as required by State law; and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2024, the Planning Commission of the City of Rialto conducted a duly noticed public hearing, as required by law, on the project, took testimony, received input from staff, the city attorney, and the Applicant; heard public testimony; discussed the proposed project, and closed the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Planning Commission of the City of Rialto as follows:

SECTION 1: The Planning Commission hereby finds all of the above recitals to be true and correct.

SECTION 2: The City of Rialto is the Lead Agency for the Project, as determined by CEQA. Based on EAR No. 2024-002 and the accompanying technical studies, the Planning Commission finds and determines that:

- 1. There are no substantial changes to the Project or the circumstances under which the Project will be carried out.
- 2. The Project will not result in significant environmental effects or substantial increases in the severity of the project site.
- 3. There is no information of substantial importance, which was known or could have been known with the exercise of reasonable diligence at the time the MND was completed.
- 4. No significant effects were identified in the MND with proposed mitigation measures incorporated.

<u>SECTION 3:</u> The Planning Commission hereby adopts EAR No. 2024-002, attached hereto as <u>Exhibit "A"</u>, prepared in accordance with CEQA for the Project.

<u>SECTION 4:</u> The Chairman of the Planning Commission shall sign the passage and adoption of this resolution and thereupon the same shall take effect and be in force.
