**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026 FUNDED BY SB-1: THE ROAD REPAIR
AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017.**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rialto must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rialto will receive an estimated \$2,817,026 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2025-26 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2018, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution no. 7318 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2019, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution no. 7499 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2020, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution no. 7605 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2021, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution no. 7731 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

1 **WHEREAS**, on June 14, 2022, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution
2 no. 7908 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

3 **WHEREAS**, on June 13, 2023, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution
4 no. 8086 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

5 **WHEREAS**, on June 11, 2024, the City Council of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution
6 no. 8240 identifying certain streets for street maintenance; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the City uses a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project
8 list to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities and that funds are
9 directed toward the highest-priority, most cost-effective projects that align with community
10 needs; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the funding from SB 1 will help the City of Rialto maintain and rehabilitate
12 streets and roads throughout the City this year and into the future; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the 2022 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment
14 found that the City's streets and roads are in a "good" condition and this revenue will help us
15 increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets
16 and roads into a "excellent" condition; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads
18 infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets
19 infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials, and practices, will have significant
20 positive co-benefits statewide.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES HEREBY
22 FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

23 **Section 1:** The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

24 **Section 2:** The City of Rialto hereby provides the list of adopted projects attached
25 hereto as **Exhibit A** that will be funded in part or solely with Fiscal Year 2025-26 Road
26 Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these
27 projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City of Rialto is reaffirming to the public and

the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:
