2 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES**  
3 **HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

4 **SECTION 1. INCORPORATION BY REFERENCE.**

5 The above recitals are true and correct and material to this ordinance. In making its  
6 findings, the City Council relied upon and hereby incorporates by reference, all staff reports,  
7 presentations, and other documentation presented to the Council in the meeting.

8 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2.12.030 OF CHAPTER 2.12 OF THE**  
9 **CITY OF RIALTO MUNICIPAL CODE.**

10 Section 2.12.030 of Chapter 2.12.030 of the Rialto Municipal Code shall be amended to  
11 read as follows:

12 “2.12.030 – Mayor.

13 The salary of the mayor, as authorized by California Government Code Section 36516.1,  
14 shall be two hundred fifty percent (250%) of the salary paid to councilmembers pursuant to  
15 Section 2.12.040 below. As of December 15, 2026, the mayor’s salary is Five thousand eight  
16 hundred ten dollars and ninety-one cents (\$5,810.91) per month.”

17 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2.12.040 OF CHAPTER 2.12 OF THE**  
18 **CITY OF RIALTO MUNICIPAL CODE.**

19 Section 2.12.040 of Chapter 2.12 of the Rialto Municipal Code shall be amended to read  
20 as follows:

21 “2.12.040 – Councilmembers.

22 Under the California Government Code Section 36516, each member of the city council,  
23 other than the mayor, shall receive a salary in the amount of two thousand three hundred twenty  
24 four dollars and thirty-six cents (\$2,324.36) per month commencing on December 15, 2026.”

25 **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2.12.050 OF CHAPTER 2.12 OF THE**  
26 **CITY OF RIALTO MUNICIPAL CODE.**

27 Section 2.12.050 of Chapter 2.12 of the Rialto Municipal Code shall be amended to read

1 as follows:

2 “2.12.050 – City clerk.

3 The salary of the city clerk shall be an amount equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of the  
4 salary paid to councilmembers. As of December 15, 2026, the city clerk’s salary is one thousand  
5 seven hundred forty-three dollars and twenty-eight cents (\$1,743.28) per month.”

6 **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2.12.060 OF CHAPTER 2.12 OF THE**  
7 **CITY OF RIALTO MUNICIPAL CODE.**

8 Section 2.12.060 of Chapter 2.12 of the Rialto Municipal Code shall be amended to read  
9 as follows:

10 “2.12.060 – City treasurer.

11 The salary of the city treasurer shall be an amount equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of  
12 the salary paid to councilmembers. As of December 15, 2026, the city treasurer’s salary is one  
13 thousand seven hundred forty-three dollars and twenty-eight cents (\$1,743.28) per month.”

14 **SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.**

15 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason  
16 held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such  
17 decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council  
18 hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each and every section, subsection,  
19 sentence, clause, or phrase not declared invalid or unconstitutional without regard to whether any  
20 portion of the ordinance would be subsequently declared invalid or unconstitutional.

21 **SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

22 This ordinance shall be in full force and effective thirty (30) days after its adoption, and  
23 shall be published and posted as required by law. However the salary adjustments provided in  
24 this ordinance shall not take effect until December 15, 2026.

25 **SECTION 8. CERTIFICATION.**

26 The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause the same to be  
27 published in the local newspaper.
