Appendix B

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

An investment, business position, interest in real property, or income is reportable if the business entity in which the investment or business position is held, the interest in real property, or the income or source of income participated in by the designated officer or employee by virtue of the officer's or employee's position. An arrangement for prospective employment, to which a prospective employer's offer of employment has been accepted by the prospective employee, is reportable as either: (1) a source of income, if the filer had received income from that employer during the period covered by the statement; or (2) a business position, if the filer had held that business position during the period covered by the statement.

DESIGNATED POSITIONS IN CATEGORY "1" MUST REPORT:

1. All investments, business positions, income, and arrangement for prospective employment; any business entity in which the person is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or reportable only if located within or subject to the jurisdiction of the City and/or any of its subdivisions, or if the business entity is doing business (or planning to do business) in the jurisdiction, or has done business within the jurisdiction at any time during the two years prior to the filing of the statement.
2. Interests in real property located in the jurisdiction, including property located within a two-mile radius of any property owned or used by the city.

DESIGNATED POSITIONS IN CATEGORY "2" MUST REPORT:

1. Investments in any business entity which, within the last two years, has contracted, or in the foreseeable future may contract with the City of Rialto, to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment to the City.
2. Income from any source which, within the last two years, has contracted, or in the foreseeable future may contract with the City of Rialto to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment to the City.
3. His/her status as a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or holder of a position of management in any business entity which, within the last two years, has contracted, or in the foreseeable future may contract with the City of Rialto to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment to the City.
