REASONABLENESS OF BID

A Section 3 bid preference may be provided to a Section 3 Business concern over a lower bid from a firm that is not responsive or less responsive to Section 3, provided that the bid receiving preference is reasonable. A reasonable bid is a bid that is not more than the value of "X" higher than the lowest bid. To determine the range of bids that may be considered for preference, known as the Zone of Consideration, use the table below to calculate the "X" factor as shown.

 - Attaching a sufficient number of Section 3 Resident Certification forms to the Section 3
 Business Certification form to demonstrate that the bidder is:
 - 51% owned by low-income residents, or
 - That 30% or more of its permanent, full-time employees are Section 3 Residents; or
 - Provides evidence of a commitment to subcontract in excess of 25% of the dollar award of all subcontractors to be awarded to Section 3 Business Concerns that meet the qualifications set forth above.

Contractor has identified a total of one (1) subcontractor for this project (Sneve Bobcat Service) with a contract amount of \$26,763.00 (17% of total contract). Contractor is not a Bona-Fide MBE/WBE contractor (See MBE/WBE Business Enterprise Tiered Compliance Plan) and contractor has not subcontracted any work to MBE/WBE firms. The Contractor initialed all good faith efforts, however only supplied supporting documentation for advertised plans and specs and for interested potential MBE/WBE contractors were provided plans and specs. Contractor did attach a Notary seal with the Good Faith Effort Evaluation Criteria and Non-Collusion Affidavit, however the "description of the attached document box" located on the Certificate of Acknowledgement does not match the documents being notarized. Contractor did not turn in the following documents with their submitted bid: Section 3 Business Certification, Section 3 Resident certification form, Section 3 Economic Opportunity Plan, and Notice of Section 3 Commitment. Contractor did not complete nor sign the Disclosure of Lobbying Activities that was submitted with their bid.

Contractor did not contract with any MBE/WBE subcontractors. Contractor initialed all good faith efforts. However only supplied supporting documentation for proof of publication and solicitation for interested MBE/WBE firms (Contractor did provide email and fax proofs of attempts at hiring qualified MBE/WBE Section 3 businesses). Contractor made written commitment to hiring Section 3 Businesses with a written commitment but did not indicate what dollar amount or %. It was determined during the review, that the subcontractors identified for the project are not bona-fide Section 3 business concerns. Contractor indicated "N/A" and did not fill out the Section 3 Economic Opportunity Plan. Contractor indicated "N/A" on Section 3 Resident Certifications, and on Section 3 Commitment Form.

Contractor did not complete nor sign the Disclosure of Lobbying Activities that was submitted with their bid. Contractor did commit to hiring a Section 3 Business with a written commitment but stated "N/A" at the top of the page and did not fill out the Section 3 Economic Opportunity Plan or Section 3 Resident Certifications. Contractor did state "TBD" on a Section 3 Commitment Form.			
RECOMMENDATIO	ON FOR SECTION 3 CONTRACT AWARD		
One identified bid fell within the applied Zone of Consideration as it pertains to Section 3 Responsiveness (C-Works Engineering Inc.) all other submitted bids fell outside of the Zone of Consideration. None of the three (3) submitted bidders supporting Section 3 documentation identified any contractor of being a Section 3 business concern as defined in the bid document. Therefore, there were no identified Section 3 Business Concerns, and therefore no bid preferences issued for this project. The City is recommending the contract award to the responsible bidder based on the lowest bid amount. Therefore, C-Works Engineering Inc. is being recommended for funding.
