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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, DETERMINING AND FIXING THE
5 RATE OF TAXES ON ALL PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CITY OF
6 RIALTO FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE CITY'S PUBLIC
7 EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM EXPENDITURES FOR
8 THE FISCAL YEAR 2023/2024

9 WHEREAS, the City of Rialto has had the authority since 1958 to levy a voter approved tax rate
10 on the property tax roll for the Public Employee Retirement System (PERS) expenditures. Subsequently,
11 City of Rialto vote approved a Utility Users Tax on June 3, 2003, upon which time the City began
12 annually setting the PERS retirement tax levy at \$0 (zero) for each \$100 of assessed valuation; and

13 WHEREAS, the State of California has established a permanent moratorium on the ability of
14 California cities to fund their retirement systems by placing them on the property tax rolls for funding.
15 As part of this legislation, the State froze the maximum assessment rate to the rates levied in Fiscal Year
16 1982/1983. The City of Rialto's rate for the 1982/1983 Fiscal Year was \$0.1506. This is the maximum
17 rate the City may levy for the 2023/2024 Fiscal Year; and

18 WHEREAS, this resolution is for the purpose of fixing the amount of money to be raised by
19 taxation and rate of taxes to be levied on the taxable property and is therefore effective immediately.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES
21 HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

22 Section 1: The City Public Employees Retirement System tax levy for the retirement fund will be
23 set to \$0 per each \$100 of assessed valuation for Fiscal Year 2023/2024.

24 Section 2: The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Resolution and cause the same to be
25 published once in a newspaper of general circulation.
