## RESOLUTION NO.\_\_\_\_

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 7911 RELATED TO THE GENERAL FUND STATE ALLOCATION GRANT FUNDS FOR THE RIALTO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT INTERNATIONAL HEALING GARDEN PROJECT TO PROGRAM THE USE OF FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION COSTS

**WHEREAS**, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have approved a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the benefit of the Rialto Unified School District (the "District") for its International Healing Garden Project, (the "Grant Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California requires that the General Fund grant awarded to the District be distributed through a Fiduciary Agent on behalf of the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Rialto (the "City") has agreed to participate as the District's Fiduciary Agent and has entered into a related agreement with the District therefore; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to the agreement with the District to participate as District's Fiduciary Agent, the City is identified as the "Grantee" of the grant funds awarded to the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Natural Resources Agency has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the Grant Project, setting up necessary procedures; and

**WHEREAS**, said procedures established by the California Natural Resources Agency require the Grantee to certify by resolution the approval of the Project Information Package before submission of said package to the State; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grantee will enter into an agreement with the State of California for the Grant Project; and

**WHEREAS,** on June 14, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 7911 to accept the grant funds on behalf of the District for the Grant Project, with the use of those grant funds for planning (design) purposes; and

**WHEREAS,** the District now desires to program the use of the grant funds for construction purposes, requiring the City Council to amend its Resolution No. 7911 to identify the use of the grant funds accordingly for construction purposes.

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## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- Amends Resolution No. 7911 in the approval and acceptance of the general fund allocation for local assistance for the subject Grant Project, with the use of the general fund allocation for construction purposes rather than programming/planning (design) purposes as previously identified in Resolution No. 7911.
- 2. Certifies that the City understands the assurances and certification in the Project Information Form.
- 3. Certifies that said agency will have sufficient funds to develop, operate and maintain the project consistent with the land tenure requirements of the Grant Agreement; or will secure the resources to do so.
- 4. Certifies that said agency will comply with the provisions of Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code.
- 5. If applicable, certifies that the project will comply with any laws and regulation including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws, environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable licenses and permits will have been obtained.
- 6. Certifies that said agency has reviewed and understands the General Provisions contained in the Project Agreement shown in the Procedural Guide.
- 7. Appoints the City Manager, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to Project Information Form, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned Grant Pproject.
