The type of "existing facilities" to be considered exempt is determined by whether the project involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use, and includes existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities. The project includes the repair, maintenance, and minor alteration of existing streets; therefore, the 2020/2021 Street Overlay & Reconstruction Project, is considered categorically exempt from CEQA.
