2 and

3 WHEREAS, the City of Rialto acknowledges that the Water and Wastewater  
4 Enterprises are challenged by increased inflation and operation costs during these  
5 economic conditions; and

6 WHEREAS, the City of Rialto is committed to alleviating the temporary financial  
7 strain on residential accounts affected by the escalating cost of living; and

8 WHEREAS, the temporary suspension of the Utility User Tax on single-family,  
9 multi-family, and mobile home water and wastewater accounts will not pose a  
10 detrimental financial impact to the City of Rialto or any of its operations; and

11 WHEREAS, the temporary suspension of the collection of the Utility User Tax  
12 does not apply to commercial, industrial, or institutional accounts.

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES**  
14 **HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

15 **Section 1:** The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein  
16 by this reference.

17 **Section 2:** Effective January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025, the City of  
18 Rialto suspends the collection of the Utility User Tax for single-family, multi-family, and  
19 mobile home water and wastewater accounts, including water accounts served by  
20 Fontana Water Company, Rialto Water Serves, and West Valley Water District.

21 **Section 2.1:** The suspension will begin with the first full billing cycle beginning  
22 after January 1, 2025, and will end with the first full billing cycle starting after January  
23 1, 2026.

24 **Section 3:** Unless acted upon by a subsequent Resolution, the collection of the  
25 Utility User Tax for single-family, multi-family, and mobile home water and wastewater  
26 accounts will recommence the first full billing cycle starting after January 1, 2026, at  
27 the rate of 8%.

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1           **WHEREFORE**, this Resolution is passed, approved, and adopted on this 23rd  
2 day of July 2024.
