- 1) Only purple cells need attention/data entry.
 - 2) Select your Jurisdiction in L2 Using Drop Down (Revenue will update automatically)
 - 3) Enter the amount of your unused MSI Local Street funds estimated at the end of the current Fiscal Year
 - 4) Type the Project Names in column B (see 5 for additional instructions)
 - 5) Please include the type of work. There's no limit on categorial projects, like pavement mgmt or routine maintenance. If adding a specific road/named project, please include road name, limits and type of work.
 - 6) Please enter yes or no as appropriate in cells C&D to indicate if the Project is in a Non-Motorized Trans Plan or has an ATP Component.
 - 7) If the Project is a Capacity Improvement Project/Arterial Project, please enter the Public/DIF Share % from the Nexus Study. Otherwise, leave blank. Please Contact SBCTA if you need help with this.
 - 8) Please enter Estimated Total Project Cost in column G. May be more than the Measure I amount.
 - 9) Please enter the amount of Measure I Local Street dollars estimated to be spent by Fiscal Year.
 - 10) Make sure the programming doesn't exceed 150% of the 5 Year Estimated Revenue + Carryover Balance. If it does, cell H60 will turn pink as a flag, and will show a % above 150%. You will need to reduce programming during the 5 years per Measure I Policy VLS-9.
 - 11) Hide/Unhide blank project lines as needed. If you need more lines to input Projects, please unhide rows up line 55. If Projects exceed 55, please contact SBCTA for a revised form.
 - 12) Only input/submit the 5 Year CIP using the SBCTA-approved form sent to you. Contact SBCTA if you encounter problems.
 - 13) All projects with expenditures MUST BE LISTED as a requirement of the Measure I Ordinance and Policy VLS-9. If an agency spends Measure I Local Street funds on a project not listed, a Revised CIP must be submitted by Sept 1 after the year where the expenditures were incurred to avoid an audit finding.
 - 14) Consider submitting CIP to SBCTA for consistency review/policy compliance prior to adoption by jurisdictions governing body. Please call SBCTA with any questions using contact person from Cover Letter.
