A RESOLUTION OF THE UTILITY AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RUA RESOLUTION NO. 08-45 IN ORDER TO APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE A REVISED FINAL CONSTRUCTION WORK AUTHORIZATION FOR THE ADVANCED METERING INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT, CITY PROJECT NO. 26AMI, THAT INCREASES THE TOTAL AMOUNT THEREOF TO \$8,000,000; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR THEIR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Rialto Utility Authority Concession Agreement ("RUA Concession Agreement"), Rialto Water Services ("RWS") operates and maintains the water and sewer system in the City of Rialto; and

WHEREAS, RWS has entered into an agreement with Veolia North Operating Services, Inc. ("Veolia") to operate and maintain the water and sewer system in the City of Rialto pursuant to the RUA Concession Agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the RUA Concession Agreement between the Rialto Utility Authority and RWS, the parties established a Water Trust Agreement to provide the financial framework for the receipt, deposit, accounting, and disbursement of revenues, reimbursements, and expenditures associated with water and wastewater utility operations and capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Rialto Utility Authority ("RUA"), RWS, and Veolia are in the process of carrying out the Advanced Metering Infrastructure Project, City Project No. 26AMI, which would replace existing manual-read water meters with smart meters and supporting communication infrastructure to enable real-time, automated collection of water usage data, improve billing accuracy, enhance leak detection, and provide customers with timely information to manage their water consumption (the "AMI Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City applied to the State of California Department of Water Resources for grant funding in the amount of \$6,000,000 for the purposes of funding the AMI Project, and such application was approved by the State of California Department of Water Resources; and

WHEREAS, the City applied to the U.S. Department of the Interior for grant funding in the amount of \$2,000,000 for the purposes of funding the AMI Project, and such application was approved by the U.S. Department of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the budget for fiscal year 2025-2026 of the RUA has been adopted by this Board in its original form, and said budget will need to be amended at times to fulfill the goals of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the RUA departments may not exceed their appropriations by character of expense, with character of expense being defined as personnel services, services and supplies, capital outlay, debt service, and transfers, without the consent of the Executive Director; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director may transfer appropriations between departments and within their respective funds, as long as those appropriations do not exceed their fund total unless approved by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board approved RUA Resolution No. 08-45, which approved the necessary actions to carry out the AMI Project, including the approval of a Final Construction Work Authorization for the AMI Project in the amount of \$7,998,719; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to amend Resolution No. 08-45 such that the total amount approved for updated Final Construction Work Authorization for the AMI Project is increased to \$8,000,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE RIALTO UTILITY AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Section 6 of Resolution No. 08-45 is hereby amended as follows:

The Board of the Rialto Utility Authority hereby approves and authorizes the Final Construction Work Authorization No. 2026-1, dated November 19, 2025, incorporated herein by this reference, ("FCWA") in the Amount of \$8,000,000 to RWS, as operated by Veolia, pursuant to the RUA Concession Agreement with the Rialto Utility Authority to implement the AMI Project. Such \$8,000,000 shall be expended and paid in the manner as provided in the FCWA. The Executive Director is further authorized to execute the FCWA and all other necessary documents related thereto.

<u>Section 3</u>. Except as expressly amended herein, all other provisions of RUA Resolution No. 08-45 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. The Executive Director, or their designee, is hereby authorized to execute all necessary agreements, amendments, and related documents with the State of California Department of Water Resources, the U.S. Department of the Interior, and any eligible sub-recipients to implement the AMI Project and to ensure compliance with grant requirements and the RUA Concession Agreement.

<u>Section 5</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
