A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL ACTING AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RIALTO ACTING AS SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF RIALTO APPROVING A RECOGNIZED OBLIGATION PAYMENT SCHEDULE PURSUANT TO SECTION 34177 OF PART 1.85 OF THE DISSOLUTION ACT

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Rialto ("Agency") was established as a community redevelopment agency that was previously organized and existing under the California Community Redevelopment Law, Health and Safety Code Sections 33000, et seq. ("CRL"), and previously authorized to transact business and exercise the powers of a redevelopment agency pursuant to action of the City Council ("City Council") of the City of Rialto ("City"); and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill x1 26 added Parts 1.8 and 1.85 to Division 24 of the California Health & Safety Code, which laws caused the dissolution and wind down of all redevelopment agencies ("Dissolution Act"); and

WHEREAS, on December 29, 2011, in the petition California Redevelopment Association v. Matosantos, Case No. S194861, the California Supreme Court upheld the Dissolution Act and thereby all redevelopment agencies in California were dissolved as of and on February 1, 2012 under the dates in the Dissolution Act that were reformed and extended thereby ("Supreme Court Decision"); and

WHEREAS, the Agency is now a dissolved community redevelopment agency pursuant to the Dissolution Act; and

WHEREAS, by a resolution considered and approved by the City Council at an open public meeting, the City chose to become and serve as the "successor agency" to the dissolved Redevelopment Agency of the City of Rialto under the Dissolution Act; and

WHEREAS, as of and on and after February 1, 2012, the City serves as the "Successor Agency" to perform functions as the successor agency under the Dissolution Act to administer the enforceable obligations of the Agency and otherwise unwind the Agency's affairs, all subject to the review and approval by a seven-member Oversight Board formed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2012, the City Council, acting as the governing board for the

Successor Agency, established rules and regulations applicable to the governance and operation of the Successor Agency, and pursuant to such resolution provided that the Successor Agency will be governed by a Board of Directors (the "Board") consisting of the members of the City Council of the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant Part 1.85 of the Dissolution Act, Section 34171(g), a "Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule" means the document setting forth the minimum payment amounts and due dates of payments required by enforceable obligations; and

WHEREAS, the City as Successor Agency has prepared a Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule ("ROPS") covering the period from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rialto, acting as the Governing Board of the successor agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Rialto, hereby finds, determines, and resolves as follows:

- **Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this resolution by this reference, and constitute a material part hereof.
- Section 2. The proposed Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule ("ROPS") known as ROPS 18-19A and 18-19B for Fiscal Year 2018-19 is approved (see Exhibit "A").
- Section 3. The Executive Director or his authorized designees on behalf of the Successor Agency shall cause the ROPS to be submitted to the County Auditor Controller, the State Controller's Office, and the Department of Finance and posted on the City's website.
- **Section 4.** The Successor Agency's Fiscal Year 2018-19 budget is adopted accordingly to ROPS, subject to approval of the by the Oversight Board and the Department of Finance (see Exhibit "B").
- Section 5. To avoid any civil penalty that may be imposed, the Successor Agency authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to make changes as necessary to ROPS before it is adopted by the Oversight Board; and after ROPS is adopted by the Oversight Board to reflect any changes made by the Oversight Board;
