A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE ROAD MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION ACCOUNT PROJECT LIST.

WHEREAS, On April 28, 2017 the Governor signed Senate Bill (SB-1), which is known as the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 to address basic road maintenance, rehabilitation and critical safety needs on both the state highway and local streets and road system; and

WHEREAS, A percentage of revenue from the tax of this new Road Maintenance Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funding will be apportioned by formula to eligible cities and counties pursuant to Streets and Highways Code (SHC) Section 2032(h) for basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety projects on the local streets and roads system; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SHC Section 2030(a), the objective of the Local Streets and Roads Program is to address deferred maintenance on the local streets and roads system through the prioritization and delivery of basic road maintenance and rehabilitation projects as well as critical safety projects. Cities and counties receiving RMRA funds must comply with all relevant federal and state laws, regulations, policies, and procedures; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SHC Section 2034, prior to receiving an apportionment of RMRA funds from the Controller in a fiscal year, a city must submit to the Commission a list of projects proposed to be funded with these funds. All projects proposed to receive funding must be included in a city budget that is adopted by the city council at a regular public meeting; and

WHEREAS, The list of projects must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful

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life of the improvement pursuant to SHC Section 2034(a)(1). The project list does not limit the flexibility of an eligible city or county to fund projects in accordance with local needs and priorities so long as the projects are consistent with RMRA priorities as outlined in SHC 2030(b) [SHC 2034(a)(1); and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator may transfer appropriations between departments and within their respective funds, as long as those appropriations do not exceed their fund total unless approved by Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City of Rialto, State of California hereby adopts the list of projects, including a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement pursuant to SHC Section 2034, as submitted to the City Council attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
