AMENDMENT 1 TO COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT NO. C13026 BETWEEN THE

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AND THE CITY OF RIALTO FOR THE RIALTO METROLINK PARKING EXPANSION PROJECT

This AMENDMENT No. 1 to the Cooperative Agreement No. C13026 ("AGREEMENT") is made and entered into by and between the San Bernardino County Transportation Authority ("SBCTA") and the City of Rialto ("CITY"). SBCTA and CITY are each a "Party" and collectively "Parties".

RECITALS:

- A. SBCTA and CITY entered into AGREEMENT dated January 24, 2013, that defined the Parties roles and responsibilities for the Rialto Metrolink Parking Expansion Project ("PROJECT"). The PROJECT will add approximately 230 parking spaces to the existing parking lot by expanding into two new locations.
- B. SBCTA will provide up to \$2.3 million of Local Transportation Funds (LTF) and Proposition 1B Public Transportation Modernization Improvement and Service Account (PTMISEA) Funds for the final design, construction, project administration, demolition and site cleanup for the PROJECT. The PTMISEA funds have an expiration date and need to be expended by June 30, 2022.
- C. The CITY split the PROJECT into two phases to avoid delays associated with right-of-way acquisition. The first phase has been completed, but efforts to acquire the needed parcels originally contemplated for the second phase were unsuccessful. The CITY evaluated alternative locations for the second phase and has selected one of the alternative locations as the preferred location. The preferred site is vacant land owned by the Rialto Housing Authority located immediately south of the Metrolink Station.
- D. Parties desire to amend the AGREEMENT to reflect the updated parking lot site locations and to update the funding table to reflect the revised use of LTF and PTMISEA funds for right-of-way acquisition.
- E. Parties also desire to amend the AGREEMENT and include a contract expiration date of June 30, 2020. This will allow SBCTA time to reallocate any remaining PTMISEA funds to a new project and expend any remaining PTMISEA funds prior to the PTMISEA funding expiration date.
- F. This Amendment shall also clarify that SBCTA is the successor-in-interest to SANBAG.

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NOW THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agree to amend the AGREEMENT as follows:

- 1. All references to SANBAG in the AGREEMENT shall mean the San Bernardino County Transportation Authority ("SBCTA").
- 2. **SECTION III**, sub-paragraph 6 shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety with the following:
 - 6. This AGREEMENT shall commence upon the Effective Date, and shall continue in full force and effect until June 30, 2020.
- 3. Add the following sub-paragraph to **SECTION III.**
 - 13. In the event that the CITY is not able to complete PROJECT prior to the AGREEMENT expiration date, SBCTA shall reallocate any remaining PTMISEA funds to other SBCTA-funded projects eligible for PTMISEA funding.
- 4. The parties agree that <u>Attachment A- Project Location</u> is hereby replaced as attached to reflect the revised parking lot site locations.
- 5. The parties agree that <u>Attachment B- Project Funding Table</u> is hereby replaced as attached to reflect the revised use of the various project funding sources.
- 6. Except as amended by this Amendment No. 1, all other provisions of the AGREEMENT remain in full force and effect.
- 7. The Recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by this reference.
