Reasons why project is exempt: This project is a Class 3 exemption pursuant to CEQA Section 15302 New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures. Class 3 consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. The numbers of structures described in this section are the maximum allowable on any legal parcel. Examples of this exemption include, but are not limited to: (d) Water main, sewage, electrical, gas, and other utility extensions, including street improvements, of reasonable length to serve such construction. Therefore, the City of Rialto constructing a water pump station to serve water to the development, is considered categorically exempt from CEQA.
