14	Management Bargaining Unit, in accordance with the Tentative Agreements;
15	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES
16	HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:
17	Section 1: That the City of Rialto approve an eight percent (8%) salary increase to Rialt
18	Police Officers' Association, General Bargaining Unit, and the Rialto Police Officers' Association
19	Management Bargaining Unit, members.
20	Section 2: That the City Council incorporate the 8% salary increases into the employees
21	compensation rates and salary schedule for the 18-19 fiscal year as provided in Exhibit A.
22	Section 3: That the increases become effective the first full pay period in July 2018.
