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# RESOLUTION NO.\_\_\_\_

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF **CALIFORNIA** APPROVING RIALTO. A MITIGATED **NEGATIVE** DECLARATION (ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT REVIEW NO. 2017-0066) FOR A PROJECT CONSISTING OF A GENEREAL PLAN AMENDMENT, A ZONE CHANGE, THE SUBDIVISION OF 4.75 ACRES OF LAND (PORTIONS OF APNS: 0131-111-05, -07, -75 & -76) LOCATED EAST OF SYCAMORE AVENUE APPROXIMATELY 630 FEET NORTH OF RANDALL AVENUE INTO THIRTY-TWO (32) SINGLE-FAMILY LOTS, ONE (1) COMMON OPEN SPACE LOT AND A STORMWATER RETENTION BASIN.

**WHEREAS**, the applicant, Asian Pacific, Inc., proposes to subdivide 4.75 acres of land (Portions APNs: 0131-111-05, -07, -75 & -76) located east of Sycamore Avenue approximately 630 feet north of Randall Avenue ("Site") into thirty-two (32) single-family lots, one (1) common open space lot and a stormwater retention basin ("Project"); and

**WHEREAS,** in conjunction with the Project, the applicant has also submitted General Plan Amendment No. 2018-0002 to change the land use designation of the Site, as described in the legal description attached as Exhibit A, from Residential 6 (2.1-6 du/acre) to Residential 12 (6.1-12.0 du/acre) ("GPA No. 2018-0002"); and

**WHEREAS,** in conjunction with the Project, the applicant has also submitted Zone Change No. 2017-0004 to change the zoning designation of the Site, as described in the legal description attached as Exhibit A, from Single-Family Residential (R-1C) to Multi-Family Residential (R-3) ("ZC No. 2017-0004"); and

**WHEREAS,** the Project within the R-3 zone requires the approval of a tentative tract map, and the Applicant has agreed to apply for a Tentative Tract Map No. 2017-0006, also referred to as Tentative Tract Map No. 20108, ("TTM No. 20108"), in accordance with the Subdivision Map Act (Government Code §§ 66410 et seq.); and

**WHEREAS,** as part of the Project, the applicant will submit a Precise Plan of Design application to allow the construction of thirty-two (32) single-family residences on the Site; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act, Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et. seq. (" CEQA"), the State's CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15000 et. seq., and Government Code Section 65962.5(f) (Hazardous Waste and Substances Statement), the City reviewed an Initial Study (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2017-0066) prepared by and determined that there is no substantial evidence that the approval of the Project would result in a significant adverse effect on the environment, provided appropriate mitigation measures are imposed on the Project; thus, a Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and notice thereof was given in the manner required by law; and

**WHEREAS,** a Notice of Intent to adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Project was published in the San Bernardino Sun newspaper, and mailed to all property owners within 300 feet of the Project Site, and a twenty (20) day public comment period was held from October 24, 2018 to November 12, 2018; and

**WHEREAS,** The Planning Division received no public comment letters during the twenty (20) day public comment period; and

**WHEREAS,** the City mailed public hearing notices for the proposed Project to all property owners within 300 feet of the project site, and published the public hearing notice in the San Bernardino Sun newspaper as required by State law; and

**WHEREAS,** on November 28, 2018, the Planning Commission of the City of Rialto conducted a duly noticed public hearing, as required by law, on the Mitigated Negative Declaration, GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No. 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108, took testimony, at which time it received input from staff, the city attorney, and the Applicant; heard public testimony; discussed the proposed GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No. 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108; and closed the public hearing; and

**WHEREAS,** on November 28, 2018, the Planning Commission voted 6-0 (1 absence) to recommend approval of the Mitigated Negative Declaration, GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No. 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108 to the City Council; and

**WHEREAS,** on January 29, 2019, the City Council conducted a public hearing, as required by law, on the Mitigated Negative Declaration, GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No. 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108, took testimony, at which time it received input from staff, the city attorney, and the applicant; heard public testimony, discussed the Mitigated Negative Declaration, GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No. 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108; and closed the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the City Council hereby finds, determines, and resolves as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby specifically finds that all of the facts set forth in the recitals above of this Resolution are true and correct and incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council has independently reviewed and considered the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration, the public comments upon it, and other evidence and finds that the Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared in the manner required by law, and there is no substantial evidence, provided appropriate mitigation measures are imposed, that the Project would result in a significant adverse effect upon the environment.

**SECTION 3.** The Initial Study (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2017-0066) prepared for the project identified that the Site did not have suitable habitat for any threatened or endangered species, and therefore the proposed Project will have no individual or cumulative adverse impacts upon resources, as defined in Section 711. 2 of the State Fish and Game Code.

**SECTION 4:** The attached proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration, Exhibit "B" hereto, finds that there are no impacts or less than significant impacts to aesthetics, agriculture and forestry resources, air quality, biological resources, geology/soils, greenhouse gas emissions, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology/water quality, land use/planning, mineral resources, population/housing, public services, recreation, transportation/traffic, tribal cultural resources, and utilities and service systems.

**SECTION 5.** With the imposition of mitigation measures that address potential impacts upon cultural resources, geology/soils, tribal cultural resources, noise, and mandatory findings of significance in the community, and as set forth in the Mitigation Monitoring & Reporting Program,

<u>Exhibit "C"</u> hereto, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, the proposed Project's potential significant impacts will be reduced below a level of significance.

**SECTION 6.** For the foregoing reasons and based on the information and findings included in the Initial Study and Staff Report, the City Council has determined that the Project, as conditioned and mitigated, will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and also finds that the preparation of the Mitigated Negative Declaration attached hereto complies with CEQA. Therefore, the City Council hereby certifies the Mitigated Negative Declaration, which is attached hereto as <a href="Exhibit "B"">Exhibit "B"</a> and incorporated herein by this reference, making certain environmental findings to allow the Project. The City Council further directs the Planning Division to file the necessary documentation with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for San Bernardino County.

**SECTION 7.** The Mayor shall sign the passage and adoption of this resolution and thereupon the same shall take effect and be in force.
