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1       **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code Sections 65350-65362, the Planning  
2 Commission shall hold a public hearing for a proposed amendment to the General Plan and forward  
3 a recommendation to the City Council for action; and

4       **WHEREAS**, on November 28, 2018, the Planning Commission of the City of Rialto  
5 conducted a duly noticed public hearing, as required by law, on GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No.  
6 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108, took testimony, at which time it received input from staff, the  
7 city attorney, and the applicant; heard public testimony; discussed GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No.  
8 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108; and closed the public hearing; and

9       **WHEREAS**, on November 28, 2018, the Planning Commission voted 6-0 (1 absence) to  
10 recommend approval of GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No. 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108 to the City  
11 Council; and

12       **WHEREAS**, on January 29, 2019, the City Council conducted a public hearing, as required  
13 by law, on GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No. 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108, took testimony, at  
14 which time it received input from staff, the city attorney, and the applicant; heard public testimony,  
15 discussed GPA No. 2018-0002, ZC No. 2017-0004, and TTM No. 20108; and closed the public  
16 hearing; and

17       **WHEREAS**, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

18       **NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council hereby finds, determines, and resolves as follows:

19       **SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby specifically finds that all of the facts set forth in the  
20 recitals above of this Resolution are true and correct and incorporated herein.

21       **SECTION 2.** Based on substantial evidence presented to the City Council during the public  
22 hearing conducted with regard to GPA No. 2018-0002, including written staff reports, verbal  
23 testimony, project plans, other documents, and the conditions of approval stated herein, the City  
24 Council hereby determines that GPA No. 2018-0002 satisfies the requirements of Government Code  
25 Section 65358 pertaining to the findings which must be made precedent to amending a General Plan.  
26 The findings are as follows:

- 27       1.       That the proposed General Plan Amendment is in the public interest.
- 28

1       *This finding is supported by the following facts:*

2       The Site is surrounded on the west, north and south by single-family residential subdivisions.  
3       The density of the proposed development is similar to the densities of other single-family  
4       residential subdivisions in the nearby area, including Pepper Ridge, which is located at  
5       northeast corner of Randall and Eucalyptus and California Knolls, which is located  
6       approximately 660 feet to the northeast of the project site. The Project will facilitate the  
7       development of detached single-family residences in keeping with the character of the  
8       surrounding area.

9       The Project will facilitate the development of a neighborhood consisting of thirty-two (32)  
10      detached single-family residences. Any member of the public seeking to purchase a new  
11      home will be provided an opportunity to acquire a new high-quality residence within a high-  
12      quality, well-maintained, gated neighborhood. An increase in the number of owner occupied  
13      single-family residences will likely positively affect the median income of the City of Rialto,  
14      albeit insignificantly. Furthermore, the development of thirty-two (32) detached single-family  
15      residences will contribute to an increase in revenues collected in form of permit fees,  
16      development impact fees, sales tax, and property tax. In addition, the Site is currently vacant  
17      unimproved land, and the general plan amendment and development of single-family  
18      residences will reduce existing blight and adverse effects of an empty, vacant lot surrounded  
19      by urban uses.

20       **SECTION 3.** An Initial Study (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2017-0066) has  
21      been prepared for GPA No. 2018-0002 in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act  
22      (CEQA) and it has been determined that any impacts will be reduced to a level of insignificance and  
23      a Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared in accordance with CEQA. The City Council  
24      concurrently herewith has adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration and directed the Planning  
25      Division to file the necessary documentation with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for San  
26      Bernardino County.

27       **SECTION 4.** The City Council hereby approves GPA No. 2018-0002 to change the land  
28      use designation of the Site from Residential 6 to Residential 12, in accordance with the applications  
29      on file with the Planning Division, subject to the following conditions:

1. GPA No. 2018-0002 is approved changing the land use designation of approximately 4.75  
acres of land (APNs: 0131-111-05, -07, -75 & -76) located east of Sycamore Avenue  
approximately 630 feet north of Randall Avenue, and described in the legal description  
attached as Exhibit A, from Residential 6 to Residential 12. If the Conditions of Approval

1 specified herein are not satisfied or otherwise completed, the Project shall be subject to  
2 revocation.

- 3 2. City inspectors shall have access to the Site to reasonably inspect the Site during normal  
4 working hours to assure compliance with these conditions and other codes.
- 5 3. The applicant shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Rialto, its agents,  
6 officers, or employees from any claims, damages, action, or proceeding against the City  
7 or its agents, officers, or employees to attack, set aside, void, or annul any approval of  
8 the City, its advisory agencies, appeal boards, or legislative body concerning GPA No.  
9 18-0002. The City will promptly notify the applicant of any such claim, action, or  
10 proceeding against the City, and applicant will cooperate fully in the defense.
- 11 4. In accordance with the provisions of Government Code Section 66020(d)(1), the  
12 imposition of fees, dedications, reservations, or exactions for this Project, if any, are  
13 subject to protest by the applicant at the time of approval or conditional approval of the  
14 Project or within 90 days after the date of the imposition of the fees, dedications,  
15 reservations, or exactions imposed on the Project.
- 16 5. The City shall prepare a Fiscal Impact Analysis report of the proposed Development at  
17 the applicant's cost. The report shall analyze the Development's impact to the City's  
18 General Fund. The applicant shall be required to mitigate any negative fiscal impacts  
19 identified in the report through the formation of a Community Facilities District, payment  
20 of a Municipal Services Fee, or other acceptable mitigation method.
- 21 6. The applicant shall comply with all conditions of approval contained in ZC No. 2017-  
22 0004 and TTM No. 20108, to the extent they are not in conflict with any condition of  
23 approval herein.

24 **SECTION 5.** The Mayor shall sign the passage and adoption of this resolution and  
25 thereupon the same shall take effect and be in force.
