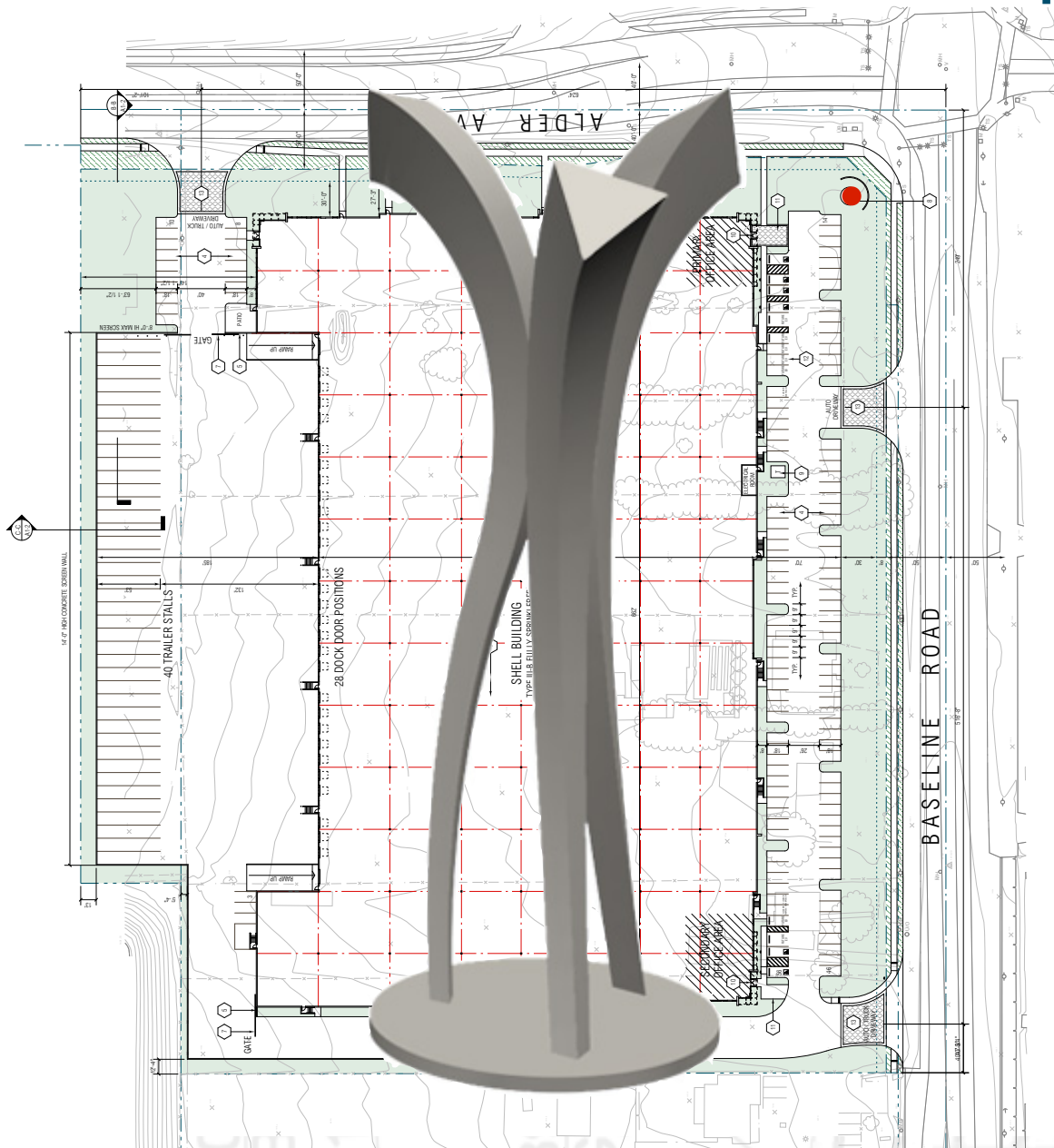

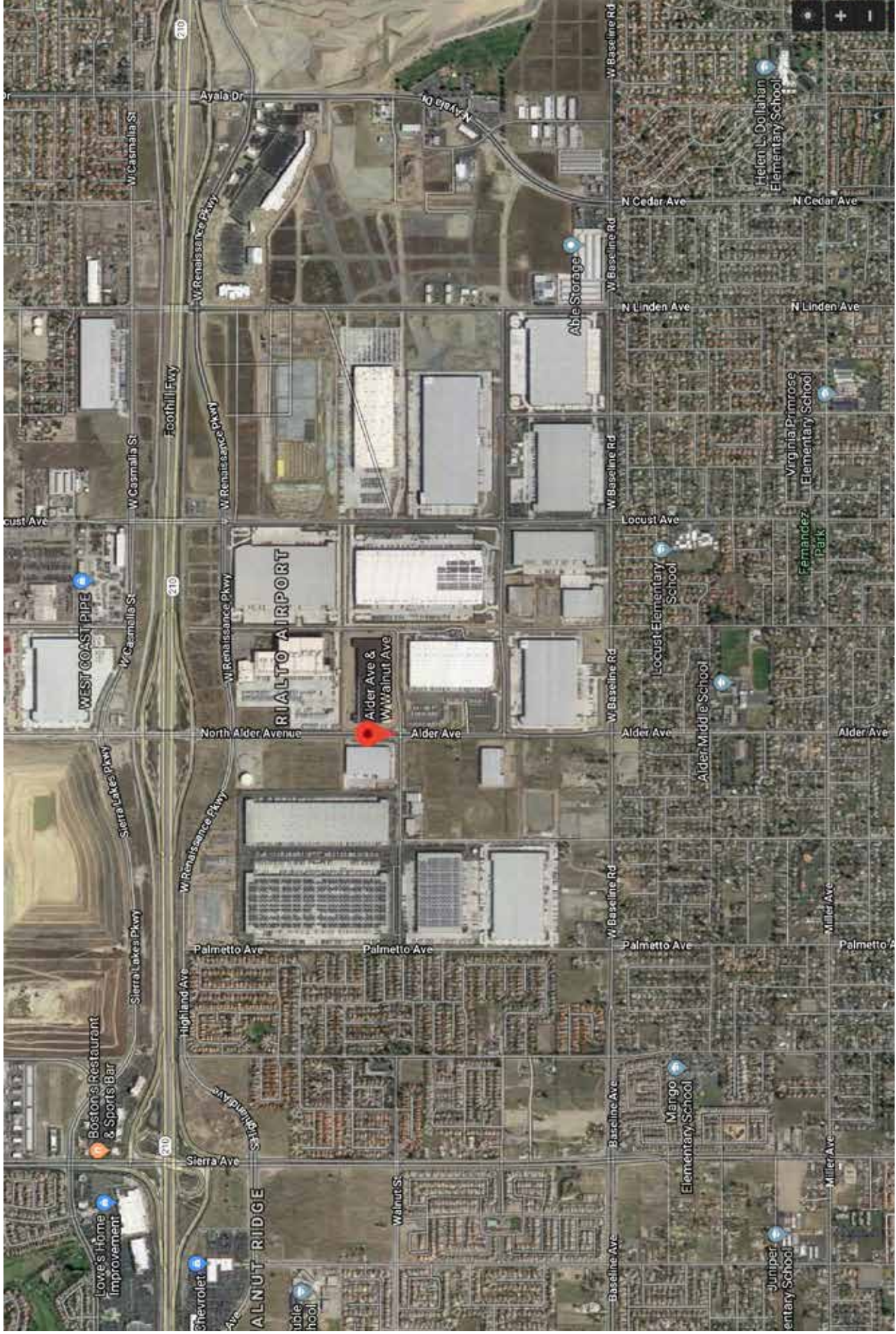

Satellite View of Location

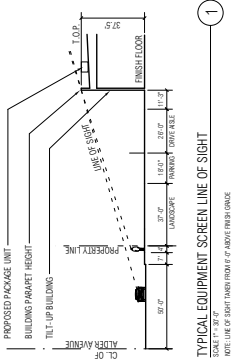
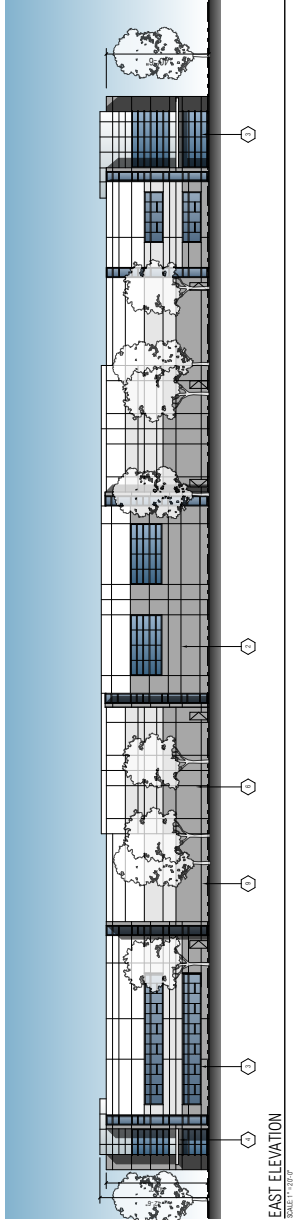
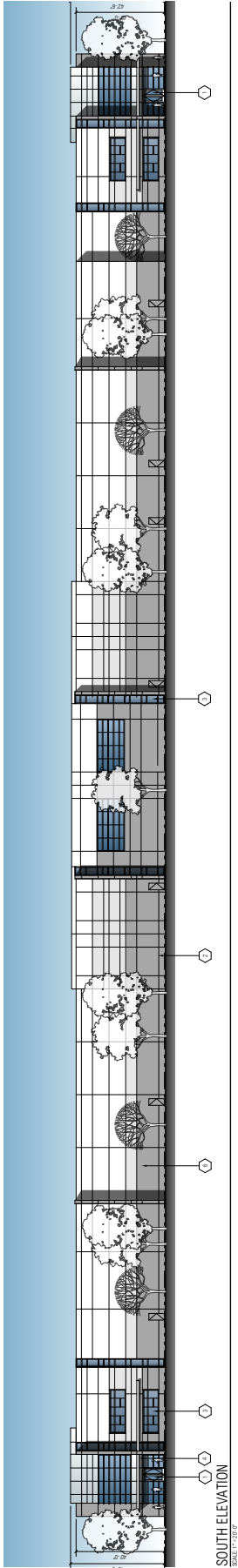
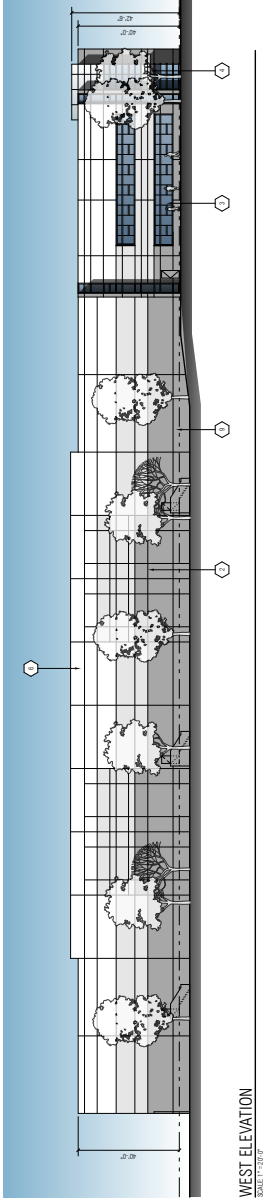
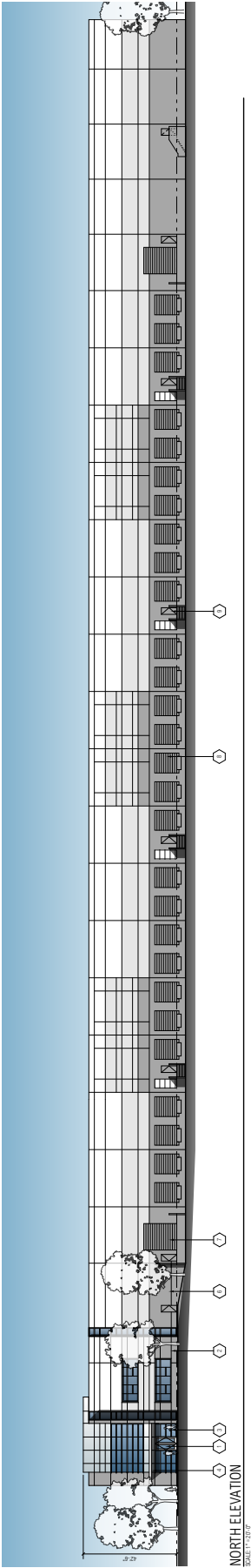

Support Archie Held

After exploring the works of over ten sculptors for this project, we narrowed our choices to three and requested initial ideas and concepts based on the location, architectural style of the building, and the proximity of the proposed location. After reviewing all of the works, we selected Archie Held as the sculptor for this project, and with revisions, chose his concept, "Support."

Artist Statement

"I intend for this sculpture to create an interesting visual contrast to the architecture. The sculpture is a playful undulating form that will have a soft light-reflecting surface."

Description

The sculpture is a vertical curving form in stainless steel, mounted on a circular base. The dimensions for "Support" are 3' 7" w x 3' 4" d x 8' h and it will weigh approximately 300 pounds.

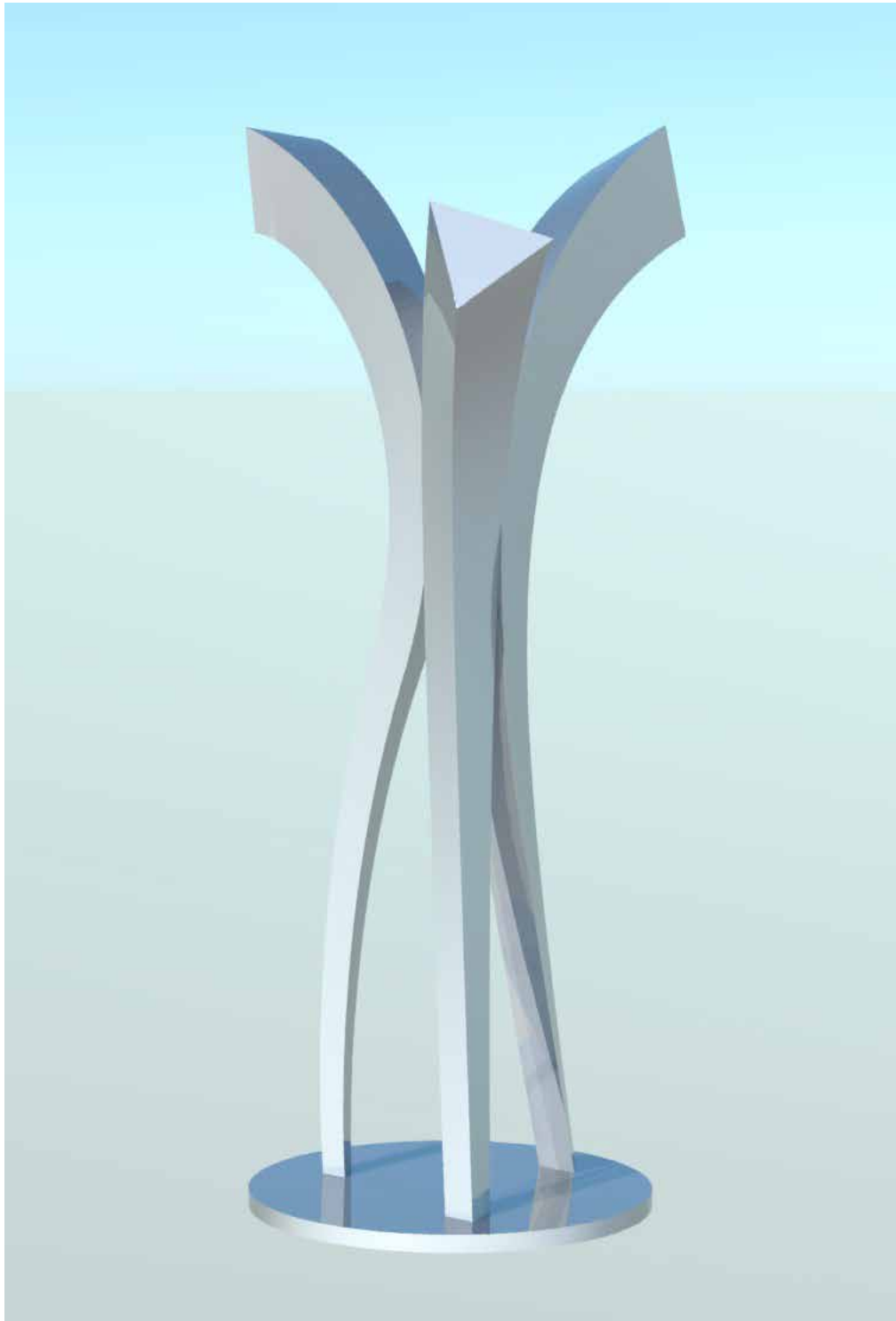
Construction and Installation

The work will all be made of high quality stainless steel and given a satin finish. The work will be made of hand formed material with all edges welded and finished. It will stand on a 3" tall stainless steel two-piece base with the mounting bolts concealed inside. As the sculpture is not very heavy for its size, it is recommended that sit on a 6" deep concrete footing that is the same size or slightly larger than the diameter of the base, which will be verified by the structural engineer.

Maintenance

The surface will be protected with a hard carnauba wax that helps facilitate the removal of surface dirt and graffiti. It is recommended that the sculpture be wiped down with a mild all-purpose cleaner or power washed to remove surface dirt at least once a year. The wax should be re-applied as needed, with a recommendation of once every three years.

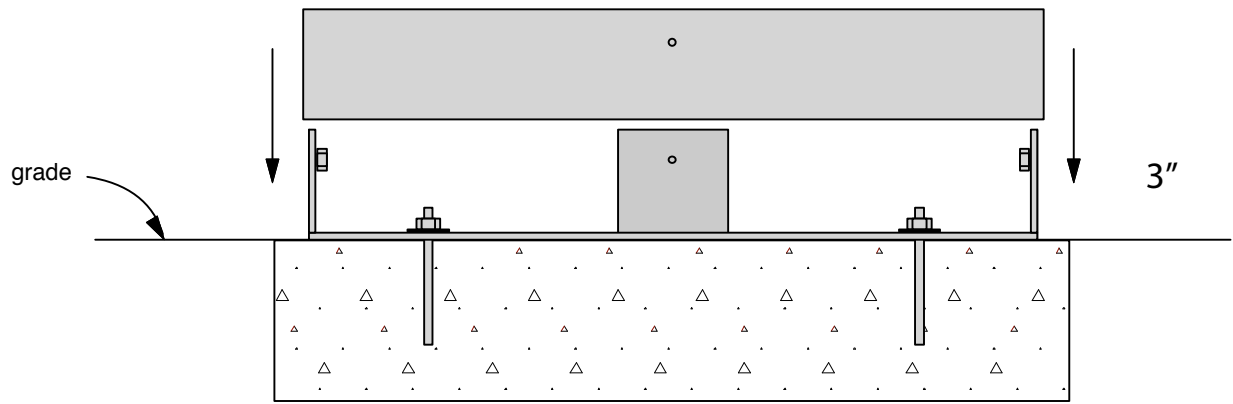
In the event of vandalism due to graffiti, the surface can be cleaned with paint remover and a rag or a low abrasive 3M Scotchbrite pad to remove the paint. Wax should then be reapplied to the affected area. If vandalism occurs with a sharp object, Archie Held Studio or an approved conservator may refinish the damaged surface.



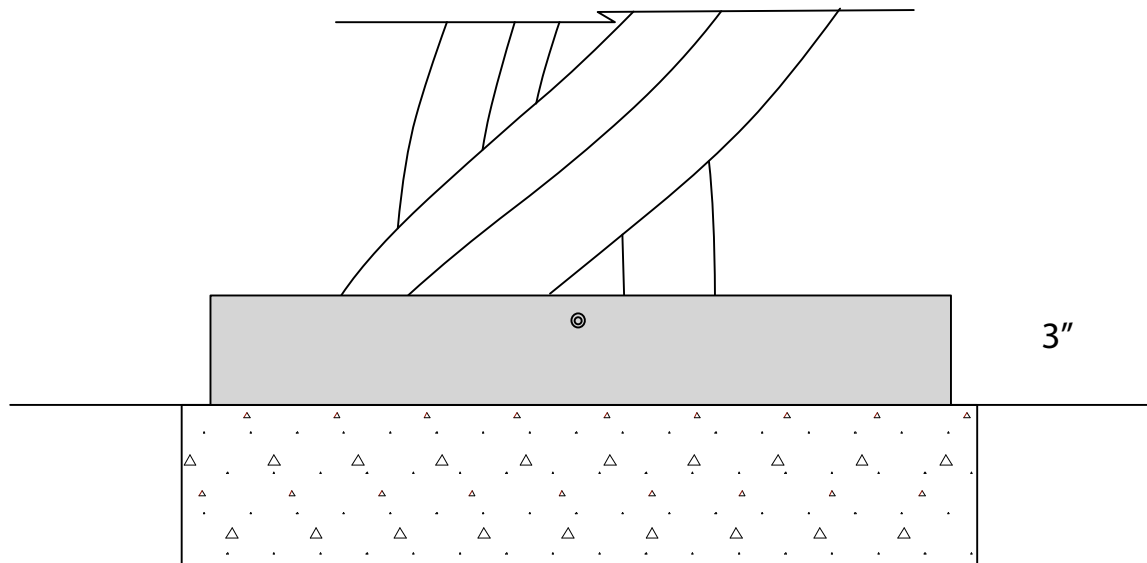

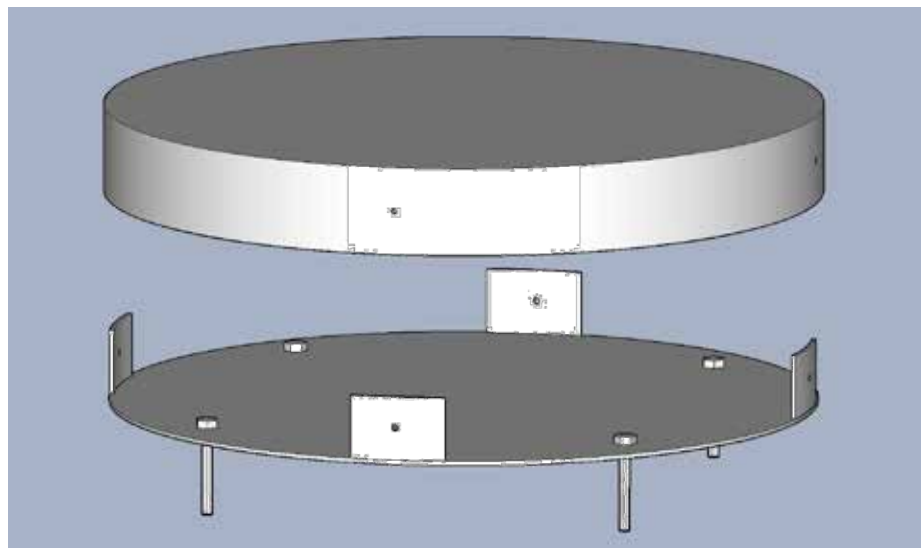
