A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE USE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Rialto receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

Program funds; and

WHEREAS, federal law requires recipients of CDBG funds to develop procedures for procurements made with CDBG funds and requires that such procedures comply with federal, state, and local law;

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2018, the Interim City Administrator issued a memo to all applicable City departments requiring the use of the Uniform Guidance (UG), which addresses the procurement procedures in all purchases using such federal funding, with the intent that such rules would be formally adopted by the City Council concurrently with the adoption of the revised purchasing ordinance.

WHEREAS, concurrent with the approval of this Resolution, the City Council is approving an amendment to the City's Purchasing Ordinance, at Chapter 2.48 of the Rialto Municipal Code;

WHEREAS, Section 2.48.480, as revised, requires that "[a]ny procurements using federal or state grant funds shall be made in compliance with all applicable federal and state laws governing such procurements, as well as any adopted city policies related to such procurements. In the event of any conflict between applicable federal or state laws governing grant-funded procurements and the provisions of this chapter, applicable federal and state laws shall govern;"

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to adopt this Resolution pursuant to Rialto Municipal Code section 2.48.480, adopting the UG for use on all applicable federal grant-funded projects for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rialto, California, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. The City Council hereby adopts the CDBG Policies and Procedures, attached
2	hereto as Exhibit A, for use by all City departments that make procurements using CDBG funds.
3	SECTION 2. The CDBG Policies and Procedures shall be updated from time to time by
4	City Council resolution to reflect changes in federal, state, and local law.
