RESOLUTION NO. <u>19-XX</u>

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY COUNCIL APPROVE A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION (ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT REVIEW NO. 2018-0099) FOR A PROJECT CONSISTING OF A SPECIFIC PLAN AMENDMENT, THE SUBDIVISION OF 4.54 GROSS ACRES OF LAND (APNS: 0131-021-36, -37, -38, & -39) LOCATED AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF WILLOW AVENUE AND BONNIE VIEW DRIVE INTO FIFTY-SIX (56) SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL LOTS AND FOUR (4) COMMON LOTS, AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF FIFTY-SIX (56) SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENCES THEREON.

WHEREAS, the applicant, RBV Investment Group, proposes to subdivide 4.54 gross acres of land (APNs: 0131-021-36, -37, -38, & -39) located at the southeast corner of Willow Avenue and Bonnie View Drive, and described in the legal description attached as Exhibit A, ("Site") into fifty-six (56) single-family lots and four (4) common lots ("Project"); and to construct fifty-six (56) single-family residences thereon; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Project, the applicant has also submitted Specific Plan Amendment No. 2017-0001 to change the zoning designation of the Site, as described in the legal description attached as Exhibit A, from Support Commercial (S-C) within the Central Area Specific Plan to Multi-Family Residential (MFR) within the Central Area Specific Plan ("SPA No. 2017-0001"); and

WHEREAS, the Project within the MFR zone requires the approval of a tentative tract map, and the Applicant has agreed to apply for Tentative Tract Map No. 2018-0007, also referred to as Tentative Tract Map No. 20199, ("TTM No. 20199"), in accordance with the Subdivision Map Act (Government Code §§ 66410 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, in conjunction herewith, the applicant proposes to develop fifty-six (56) single-family residences on the Site, and SPA No. 2017-0001 and TTM No. 2018-0007 are necessary to facilitate said development ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, as part of the Project, the applicant also submitted Precise Plan of Design No. 2018-0094 ("PPD No. 2018-0094") to construct fifty-six (56) single-family residences on the Site; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act, Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et. seq. ("CEQA"), the State's CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15000 et. seq., and Government Code Section 65962.5(f) (Hazardous Waste and Substances Statement), the City reviewed an Initial Study (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2018-0099) prepared by Blodgett Baylosis Environmental Planning and determined that there is no substantial evidence that the approval of the Project would result in a significant adverse effect on the environment, provided appropriate mitigation measures are imposed on the Project; thus, a Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and notice thereof was given in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Intent to adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Project was published in the San Bernardino Sun newspaper, and mailed to all property owners within 300 feet of the Site, and a twenty (20) day public comment period was held from April 24, 2019 to May 13, 2019; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Division received no public comment letters during the twenty (20) day public comment period; and

WHEREAS, the City mailed public hearing notices for the proposed Project to all property owners within 300 feet of the project site, and published the public hearing notice in the San Bernardino Sun newspaper as required by State law; and

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2019, the Planning Commission of the City of Rialto conducted a duly noticed public hearing, as required by law, on the Mitigated Negative Declaration, SPA No. 2017-0001, and TTM No. 20199, took testimony, at which time it received input from staff, the city attorney, and the Applicant; heard public testimony; discussed the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration, SPA No. 2017-0001, and TTM No. 20199; and closed the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, all legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Planning Commission of the City of Rialto as follows:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> The Planning Commission hereby finds all of the above recitals to be true and correct.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The Planning Commission has independently reviewed and considered the proposed Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (Environmental Assessment Review No. 2018-0099) attached hereto as <u>Exhibit "B"</u> and incorporated herein by this reference, the public comments upon it, and other evidence and finds that the Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared in the manner required by law, and there is no substantial evidence in the record to support a fair argument that the Project would result in a significant adverse effect upon the environment, provided appropriate mitigation measures are imposed as recommended below.

<u>SECTION 3:</u> The Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the Project identified that the Site did not have suitable habitat for any threatened or endangered species, and therefore the proposed Project will have no individual or cumulative adverse impacts upon such resources, as defined in Section 711. 2 of the State Fish and Game Code.

<u>SECTION 4:</u> The attached proposed Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration finds that there are no impacts or less than significant impacts to aesthetics, agriculture and forestry resources, air quality, cultural resources, energy, greenhouse gas emissions, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology/water quality, land use/planning, mineral resources, population/housing, public services, recreation, transportation/traffic, tribal cultural resources, utilities and service systems, and wildfire.

<u>SECTION 5:</u> With the imposition of mitigation measures that address potential impacts upon biological resources, geology and soils, noise, and mandatory findings of significance in the community, and as set forth in the Mitigation Monitoring & Reporting Program, <u>Exhibit "C"</u> hereto, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, the proposed Project's potential significant impacts will be reduced below a level of significance.

<u>SECTION 6:</u> For the foregoing reasons and based on the information and findings included in the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration, technical reports, Mitigation

Monitoring and Reporting Program, Staff Report, public testimony, and all other documents and evidence in the administrative record of proceedings, the Planning Commission has determined that the Project, as conditioned and mitigated, will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and also finds that the preparation of the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration attached hereto complies with CEQA. Therefore, the Planning Commission recommends that the City Council certify the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration and adopt the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, making certain environmental findings to allow the Project.

<u>SECTION 7:</u> The Chairman of the Planning Commission shall sign the passage and adoption of this resolution and thereupon the same shall take effect and be in force.
