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WHEREAS, the Active Transportation Program (ATP) was created by Senate Bill 99 (Chapter 359, Statutes of 2013) and Assembly Bill 101 (Chapter 354, Statutes of 2013) to encourage increased use of active modes of transportation, such as biking and walking.

WHEREAS, the Senate Bill 1 (SB-1) stipulates that \$100,000,000 of revenues from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account will be made available annually to the ATP.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to statute, the purpose of the program is to encourage increased use of active modes of transportation, such as biking and walking with the goals of increase the proportion of trips accomplished by biking and walking; increase the safety and mobility of non-motorized users; advance the active transportation efforts of regional agencies to achieve greenhouse gas reduction goals as established pursuant to Senate Bill 375 (Chapter 728, Statutes of 2008) and Senate Bill 391 (Chapter 585, Statutes of 2009); enhance public health,

1 including reduction of childhood obesity with programs including, but not limited to, projects
2 eligible for Safe Routes to School Program funding; ensure that disadvantaged communities
3 fully share in the benefits of the program, and provide a broad spectrum of projects to benefit
4 many types of active transportation users.

6 **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES**
7 **HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

8 **Section 1:** Accept the California SB-1 Public Transportation- Active Transportation
9 Program Grant in the amount of \$549,000 for the a non-infrastructure Safe Routes for Active
10 Play, Work, and Live Rialto!; and

11 **Section 2:** Accept the California SB-1 Public Transportation- Active Transportation
12 Program Grant in the amount of \$663,000 for the Terra Vista Drive Neighborhood SRTS
13 Infrastructure Improvements.

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem, City Administrator,
15 Public Works Director or Public Works Program Coordinator in his or her absence, is hereby
16 authorized as Signature Authority to execute all documents necessary to implement and
17 secure payment with the State of California Department of Transportation; and

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this authorization is effective until rescinded by the
19 Signature Authority or this Governing Body.
