Reasons why project is exempt: Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alternation of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination. The type of "existing facilities" to be considered exempt is determined by whether the project involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use, and includes (a) Interior or exterior alterations involving such things as interior partitions, plumbing, and electrical conveyances. Therefore, the City of Rialto: Rehabilitation of Buildings 200 – 500, gymnasium restrooms, basketball court resurfacing, bleachers installation at the Community Center, CB1804, CB1901, and installation of baseball field fencing at Bud Bender Park, 275 N. Lilac Avenue is considered categorically exempt from CEQA.
