A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

WHEREAS, The Political Reform Act of 1974 (Government Code section 81000,et seq.) (hereinafter the "PRA") requires the City to adopt and maintain a conflict of interest code; and

WHEREAS, the PRA further requires the City to conduct biennial reviews of its conflict of interest code and to make any changes necessary to comply with the requirements of the PRA; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously enacted a conflict of interest code in compliance with the PRA and conducted the required biennial reviews; and

WHEREAS, the City most recently amended its conflict of interest code by adopting
Resolution No. 7451 on January 22, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted its current biennial review as required by Government Code section 87306 and determined that changed circumstances necessitate an amendment to the conflict of interest code; and

16 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rialto California, does resolve, declare,
17 determine and order as follows:

SECTION ONE. The City of Rialto's conflict of interest code, as previously amended by Resolution No. 5790, is hereby amended by amending Exhibit "A" thereto to read, in its entirety, as set forth in Exhibit "A" hereto. All persons listed on Exhibit "A" hereto shall disclose all information required by Form 700, Statement of Economic Interests prepared by the Fair Political Practices Commission of the State of California, or such other form as may be substituted thereof from time to time.

Code.
