BACKGROUND

The Action Plan will appropriate CDBG, funds to specific programs and projects for the 2021-2022 fiscal year. The City anticipates receiving \$1,248,066 in federal community development funds for the 2021-2022 Program Year to implement programs and projects that benefit low- and moderate-income residents. In the event that the actual amount of CDBG funding received from HUD is higher or lower than anticipated, the City will adjust the funding amounts for each project/activity identified in the draft One-Year Action Plan proportionally and in compliance with regulatory requirements for funding allocations to certain types of CDBG projects/activities.
