A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO ACKNOWLEDGING **RECEIPT** OF REPORT MADE BY THE FIRE CHIEF OF THE RIALTO FIRE **DEPARTMENT** REGARDING THE **INSPECTION REOUIRED CERTAIN OCCUPANCIES** TO **PERFORM** ANNUAL **INSPECTIONS** IN **SUCH OCCUPANCIES** PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 13146.2 AND 13146.3 OF THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE.

**WHEREAS,** California Health & Safety Code Section 13146.4 was added in 2018 in conjunction with SB1205, and became effective on September 27, 2018; and,

**WHEREAS**, Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 requires all fire departments, including the Rialto Fire Department, that provide fire protection services to perform annual inspections in every building used as a public or private school, hotel, motel, lodging house, apartment house, and certain residential care facilities for compliance with building standards, as provided and,

WHEREAS, California Health & Safety Code Section 13146.4 requires all fire departments, including the Rialto Fire Department, that provide fire protection services to report annually to its administering authority on its compliance with Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 and,

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Rialto intends this Resolution to fulfill the requirements of Section 13146.4 of the California Health & Safety Code regarding acknowledgment of the Rialto Fire Department's compliance with California Health and Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Rialto does hereby resolve as follows: The City Council acknowledges its receipt of the report from the Fire Chief of the City of Rialto regarding the Fire Department's measure of compliance with California Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 in the area encompassed by the City of Rialto, as follows:

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#### A. EDUCATIONAL GROUP E OCCUPANCIES:

Educational Group E occupancies are generally those public and private schools, used by more than six persons at any one time for educational purposes through the 12th grade. Within the City of Rialto, there are 33 Group E occupancies, buildings, structures and/or facilities.

During calendar year 2020, the Rialto Fire Department completed the annual inspection of all 33 Group E occupancies, buildings, structures, and/or facilities. This is a compliance rate of 100% for this reporting period.

### B. RESIDENTIAL GROUP R OCCUPANCIES:

Residential Group R occupancies, for the purposes of this resolution, are generally those occupancies containing sleeping units, and include hotels, motels, apartments (three units or more), etc. as well as other residential occupancies (including a number of residential care facilities). These residential care facilities have a number of different sub-classifications, and they may contain residents or clients that have a range of needs, including those related to custodial care, mobility impairments, cognitive disabilities, etc. The residents may also be non-ambulatory or bedridden. Within the City of Rialto, there are 378 Group R (and their associated sub-categories) occupancies of this nature.

During calendar year 2020 the Rialto Fire Department completed the annual inspection of all 378 Group R occupancies, buildings, structures, and/or facilities. This is a compliance rate of 100% for this reporting period.
