

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM
DRAFT CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER) FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021**

Pursuant to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, the City of Rialto has prepared the draft Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER) for the 2020-2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Year.

The CAPER provides an assessment of the City's performance in meeting Fiscal Year 2020-2021 housing and community development goals as outlined in the previously adopted Fiscal Year 2020-2021 One-Year Action Plan. Additionally, the CAPER discusses changes the City anticipates making in the upcoming year as a result of the assessment of FY 2020-2021 annual performance.

In compliance with the City's approved Citizen Participation Plan and the Consolidated Plan implementing regulation 24 CFR 91.105, this notice is hereby given that the City of Rialto has prepared the draft CAPER for FY 2020-2021. A copy of the CAPER is required to be made available to the public for review and comment for a fifteen (15) day period.
