RESOLUTION NO. 2021-XXXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, SUMMARILY VACATING AND ABANDONING THOSE PORTIONS OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR ORCHARD STREET, MARCELLO AVENUE, AND PORTIONS OF JOYCE AVENUE GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF ACACIA AVENUE AND NORTH OF EAST JAMES AVENUE WITHIN TRACT MAP NO. 17708.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, CALIFORNIA, FINDS AND DETERMINES:

- A. The City Council of the City of Rialto, California, is authorized by Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 4, of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California (the "statute"), to summarily vacate a public street or highway, or parts thereof, within the limits of the City.
- B. Pursuant to Section 8331 of the statute, the City Council may consider summarily vacating a public street or highway if the following conditions are satisfied: ((1) for a period of five consecutive years, the street or highway has been impassable for vehicular travel, and (b) no public money was expended for maintenance on the street or highway during such period.
- C. The Planning Commission conditionally approved Tentative Tract Map No. 17708 on May 30, 2007 and said conditions stated "the necessary right of way shall be dedicated for Joyce Avenue, Orchard Street and Marcella Avenue for private streets and other facilities...". The conditions of approval also required the community to be gated.
- D. The City Council approved Tract Map No. 17708 on November 22, 2017 and the County Recorder's Office recorded the final map on December 29, 2017 as Instrument No. 2017-0554325 in Book 348 of Maps, Pages 97 99, (the "Final Map"). The Final Map included an offer by the owner to dedicate to the City of Rialto, the public in general and

public utility companies, and the City Council on behalf of the same accepted "an easement for streets and public utilities, sewer, emergency access, in, under, over, through and across Orchard Street, Marcella Avenue and Joyce Avenue, subject to improvement as shown on this final map."

- E. The language in the Final Map for the offer of dedication and acceptance of "an easement for streets" constitutes a street dedication for right of way to the public and not establishment of easements for private streets by the owner for the benefit of lot owners within the Final Map as was required in the Planning Commission's conditional approval of Tentative Map No. 17708.
- F. The best solution to resolve the incorrect offer of dedication and acceptance of public street right of way for the private streets within the Final Map is to vacate the public right of way dedicated and accepted for Orchard Street, Marcella Avenue, and Joyce Avenue, all located within the Final Map (hereinafter the "Vacation Area"), as described herein on Exhibit A and depicted on Exhibit B to this Resolution, pursuant to Section 8331 of the statute.
- G. In accordance with California Government Code section 65402, the proposed summary vacation and abandonment of portions of Orchard Street, Marcella Avenue, and Joyce Avenue, all located within the Final Map, was submitted to and reported upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Rialto.
- H. On September 8, 2021, the Planning Commission of the City of Rialto adopted Resolution No. XXXX determining that the proposed vacation and abandonment of portions of Orchard Street, Marcella Avenue, and Joyce Avenue, all located within the Final Map, was in conformance with the Rialto General Plan.

I. The portions of Orchard Street, Marcella Avenue, and Joyce Avenue, all located within the Final Map were impassable for vehicular travel and have not been continuously used for a period of five consecutive years, and no public money was expended for maintenance on the streets.

J. Section 21084 of the California Public Resources Code requires Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), and pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines, Section 15060(c)(2) (the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment) and 15060(c)(3) (the activity is not a project as defined in Section 15378) the action to adopt this Resolution summarily vacating the portions of Orchard Street, Marcella Avenue, and Joyce Avenue, all located within the Final Map is considered categorically exempt from CEQA.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> The findings and determinations reflected above are true and correct, and are incorporated by this reference herein as the cause and foundation for the action taken by and through this Resolution.

Section 2: The City Council does hereby find that the portions of Orchard Street, Marcella Avenue, and Joyce Avenue, all located within the Final Map (hereinafter the "Vacation Area"), as described herein on Exhibit A and depicted on Exhibit B to this Resolution, are unnecessary for present or prospective use as public streets and should be established as private streets for the sole benefit of the owners of lots within the Final Map.

<u>Section 3:</u> The City Council does hereby declare that this summary vacation is being made under and pursuant to the California Streets and Highways Code Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 4, Summary Vacation, Section 8331.

Section 4: Subject to Sections 5 and 6, the City Council does hereby vacate and abandon all of the City's right, title and interest in the Vacated Area, and that from and after

the date this Resolution is recorded in the records of the San Bernardino County Recorder, those portions of the public streets known as Orchard Street, Marcella Avenue, and Joyce Avenue within the Vacated Area shall no longer constitute public streets.

<u>Section 5:</u> The City of Rialto hereby reserves and excepts from the foregoing vacation an easement for public utility purposes with the right to at any time, or from time to time, construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, and renew sanitary sewers, water lines, and storm drains and appurtenant structures and to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, and other convenient structures, equipment, and fixtures and the operation of gas pipelines, telephone, cable, electric and appurtenant structures over the Vacation Area.

Section 6: Prior to the recordation of this Resolution to summarily vacate those portions of the public streets known as Orchard Street, Marcella Avenue, and Joyce Avenue within the Vacated Area, the underlying fee owner of the Final Map shall provide to the City Attorney, in a form acceptable to and approved by the City Attorney, a legally sufficient document to establish common access and easement rights across the Vacated Area for the benefit of owners of lots within the Final Map. An original executed document in such form acceptable for recordation with the San Bernardino County Recorder shall be delivered to the City Clerk for concurrent recordation by the City Clerk immediately following the recordation of this Resolution. The underlying fee owner of the Final Map shall be responsible for depositing funds with the City Clerk as may be required by the San Bernardino County Recorder to record the document.

<u>Section 7:</u> The City Clerk of the City of Rialto shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution, attested by the Clerk under seal, to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of the County of San Bernardino, concurrently with the document furnished therewith pursuant to Section 6.
