NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND REVIEW
DRAFT ACTION PLAN SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT NO. 4
2020-2021 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Rialto has prepared a Draft Substantial Amendment No. 4 to the 2020 Action Plan to include budget revisions to the Community Development Block Grant COVID-19 (CDBG-CV) special allocation the City received that totaled \$1,339,584. This amendment is conducted in accordance with guidance provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The Substantial Amendment No. 4, Budget Amounts to CDBG-CV Activities within the 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan, provides the following recommendations which may be added, increased reduced, or eliminated:

- Discussion of the reduction and reallocation of previously allocated CDBG-CV funds from the Utility Assistance Program to other established assistance programs
- Discussion of the reduction and reallocation of previously allocated CDBG-CV funds from the Small Business Assistance Program to other established assistance programs
- Consideration of the increase of the level of assistance within the Rialto Utility Assistance Program from \$210 per applicant to \$500 per applicant with previous recipients having the opportunity to receive additional grant funds up to the \$500 assistance cap between their first award and potential second award. In addition, the City will establish an end date and create a notification letter to previously approved Rental/Mortgage Assistance applicants on a first come, first serve basis to apply for the balance of any new assistance amount.
- Discontinue the requirement to apply for only one form of assistance between Rental/Mortgage and Utility.
- Remove the requirement that Small Businesses must be in operation since at least January 1, 2020

In accordance with the City's Adopted Citizen Participation Plan, the City will provide the amendments for review and comment for a fifteen-day period on the City's website prior to a public hearing.
