Request City Council to Cancel the Regular 2020 City Council meeting dates of August 25, October 13, October 27, November 24 and December 22, 2020.

### **BACKGROUND**

Historically, the City Council would cancel the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting in August for summer recess and the October meetings during the Pre-Election period, as well as the Thanksgiving and Christmas Holiday period.

### **ANALYSIS/DISCUSSION**

City Council to consider canceling the following regular meeting dates as requested due to the following reasons:

- The meeting of August 25 for summer recess.
- The meetings of October 13 and October 27, Pre-Election period.
- The meeting of November 24 Thanksgiving Holiday week.
- The meeting of December 22 Christmas Holiday week.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT**

The proposed action does not meet the definition of a project as defined by Section 15378 California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). A "Project" means the whole of an action, which has a potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and excludes organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.
