Request City Council to Adopt **Resolution No.** <u>7432</u> Declaring the November 6, 2018 Statewide General Election Results.

BACKGROUND:

A General Election was held and conducted in the City of Rialto on November 6, 2018 for the purpose of electing two members of the Rialto City Council.

ANALYSIS/DISCUSSION:

The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters Office canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results pursuant to the requirements of Resolution No. <u>7357</u> adopted by the Rialto City Council July 16, 2018.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT:

The request is not a Project as defined by Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). A "Project" means the whole of an action, which has a potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. Pursuant to Section 15378 (b)(5) a project does not include organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.
