Request City Council to Cancel the Regular 2020 City Council meeting dates of August 25, October 13, October 27, November 24 and December 22, 2020.

BACKGROUND

Historically, the City Council would cancel the 2_{nd} meeting in August for summer recess and the October meetings during the Pre-Election period, as well as the Thanksgiving and Christmas Holiday period.

ANALYSIS/DISCUSSION

City Council to consider canceling the following regular meeting dates as requested due to the following reasons:

- The meeting of August 25 for summer recess.
- The meetings of October 13 and October 27, Pre-Election period.
- The meeting of November 24 Thanksgiving Holiday week.
- The meeting of December 22 Christmas Holiday week.
